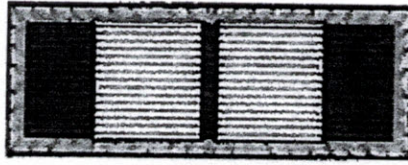

FOR EXCEPTIONALLY SUPERIOR SERVICE FROM THE PERIOD 22 AUGUST, 2017 TO 22 SEPTEMBER, 2017, THE TEXAS STATE GUARD DISTINGUISHED ITSELF THROUGH EXTRAORDINARILY MERITORIOUS SERVICE, GALLANTRY, ESPRIT DE CORPS, AND PLACING THE WELFARE OF FELLOW TEXANS AT THE FOREFRONT OF ALL ACTIONS. AS PART OF THE EMERGENCY RESPONSE FOR HURRICANE HARVEY, THE TEXAS STATE GUARD CONDUCTED MORE THAN 2100 WATER RESCUE AND EVACUATION MISSIONS; COORDINATED SAFE SHELTERING OF MORE THAN 45,000 DISPLACED TEXANS; ESTABLISHED AND OPERATED MORE THAN 20 SHELTERS ACROSS THE STATE. THE TEXAS STATE GUARD'S COMMITMENT WAS INSTRUMENTAL IN THE STATE OF TEXAS' OVERALL RESPONSE TO THIS UNPARALLELED NATURAL DISASTER. THESE ACTIONS REFLECT GREAT CREDIT UPON THE TEXAS STATE GUARD, THE STATE OF GEORGIA AND THE STATE GUARD ASSOCIATION OF THE UNITED STATES.
