## **RESOLUTION FOR Tyler County**

## APPROVAL of the Tyler County Hazard Mitigation Action Plan 2020

**WHEREAS**, natural hazards in Tyler County and historically have caused disasters with losses of life and property and natural resources damage; and

**WHEREAS**, the Federal Disaster Mitigation Act of 2000 and Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA) require communities to adopt a hazard mitigation action plan to be eligible for the full range of predisaster and post disaster federal funding for mitigation purposes; and

**WHEREAS**, FEMA requires communities to update Hazard Mitigation Action Plans every five years in order to be eligible for the full range of pre-disaster and post-disaster federal funding for mitigation purposes; and

**WHEREAS**, Tyler County has assessed their potential risks and hazards and is committed to planning for a sustainable water supply district and reducing the long-term consequences of natural and man-caused hazards; and

**WHEREAS**, the Tyler County Hazard Mitigation Action Plan outlines a mitigation vision, goals and objectives; assesses risk from a range of hazards; and identifies risk reduction strategies and actions for hazards the threaten the community.

## NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED THAT:

- 1. The Tyler County Hazard Mitigation Action Plan is approved in its entirety;
- 2. Tyler County will pursue available funding opportunities for implementation of the proposals designated therein, and will, upon receipt of such funding or other necessary resources, seek to implement the actions contained in the mitigation strategies;
- 3. Tyler County vests with the County Judge the responsibility, authority and means to inform all parties of this action; assure that the Hazard Mitigation Action Plan will be reviewed at least annually; and that any needed adjustments will be presented to the County Commissioners for consideration; and
- 4. Tyler County agrees to take such other action as may be reasonably necessary to carry out the objectives of the Plan and report on progress as required by FEMA and the Texas Division of Emergency Management (TDEM).
