### ORDER PROHIBITING OUTDOOR BURNING

**WHEREAS**, the Texas Forest Service has determined that circumstances present in all or part of the unincorporated area of the county create a public safety hazard that would be exacerbated by outdoor burning;

**IT WAS ORDERED** by the County Judge of Tyler County that all outdoor burning is prohibited in the unincorporated area of the county. The Order is ratified pursuant to Local Government Code §352.081, and other applicable statutes. The Order does not prohibit outdoor burning activities related to public health and safety that are authorized by the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality for: (1) firefighter training; (2) public utility, natural gas pipeline or mining operations; (3) planting or harvesting of agricultural crops; or, (4) burns that are conducted by a prescribed burn manager certified under Section 153.048, Natural Resources Code, and meet the standards of Section 153.047, Natural Resources Code.

**IN ACCORDANCE** with Local Government Code §352.081(h), a violation of this Order is a Class C misdemeanor, punishable by a fine not to exceed \$500.00.
