Dear Judge Powers,

We appreciate the opportunity to submit this proposal for Architectural Services for the referenced project for your approval. The LaBiche Architectural Group, Inc. (hereinafter "Architect") shall provide to Tyler County Commissioners Court, (hereinafter "Client") the services described below for the compensation described below. This proposal is based upon our discussions during our meeting on Thursday, October 17, 2024 in which we met with Tyler Co. Historical Commission members Mary Hall & Sarah Clymer.

PROJECT INFORMATION:

The project, as we understand it, is to replace the north entry doors on the 1st and 2nd floors and the 2nd floor interior doors to the Clerk's offices as indicated on the attached floor plans.

SCOPE OF WORK:

The Architect and the Architect's consultants shall perform those services described below:

Scope of Work

A. Items of work to be considered by Client:

 Restoration of the 4 doors indicated on the attached floor plan windows which were not restored in Phase II. Architectural Proposal for Tyler County Courthouse Door Rehabilitation

B. Scope of Work

- 1. Provide Construction Documents for the work identified in Scope of Work.
- 2. Secure THC approval of project scope.
- 3. Provide Construction Administration during the Construction period.
- 4. Provide THC with a final report upon completion of the work.
- Provide the County with copies of any and all documents prepared under this contract, including, but not limited to reports, plans, correspondence to and from the Texas Historical Commission, statements, forms, etc.

TERMS

Architect shall not provide Structural, Mechanical, Electrical and Plumbing Engineering services for the project.

COMPENSATION:

The scope of work outlined above will be performed for a fixed fee of Twenty Thousand Dollars (\$20,000.00), plus reimbursable expenses and distributed as follows:

Additional Services requested by Client will be charged hourly per the fee schedule attached.
Reimbursable expenses shall include all printing required for the project. Other expenses shall be
pproved by Owner prior to expenditures. Cost of reimbursable expenses shall be billed at 1.25 times the expenditure.

We have assembled this proposal based on our understanding of the specific needs related to this project. If you are in agreement with the terms and qualifications of this proposal, please sign one copy and return to us.





Good Afternoon, Everyone,

A few days ago James Malanaphy forwarded me an email string regarding the offer by the TCHC to reimburse the cost of some doors for the Courthouse.

As you may recall, the original offer was to reimburse the cost of three interior doors on the second floor.

However, some months ago, that offer was revised to include only two interior doors and to add the two exterior doors on the front (north side) of the Courthouse which the TCHC sees as the final step of the exterior work, bringing the doors back to the 1937 style in line with the current exterior appearance. I know Mary Nell was involved in some of those conversations on behalf of the Courthouse Preservation Corporation that holds the funds and can provide details of how that all came about.

In March of this year Mary Nell requested to Judge Powers' office that I, as chair of the TCHC, be sent a copy of a letter from Dohn LaBiche to Judge Powers regarding the current proposal (see attached). I don't know the details of how Mr. LaBiche was asked to provide the estimate.

I believe the information in the attached letter is the information James is requesting in his reply to Meagan. This is the proposed scope of work that the TCHC is offering to reimburse, up to \$65,000. I don't know what the County is wishing to do.

I hope this helps clarify the work that TCHC is offering to reimburse to the County.
