Commissioner Marshall motioned to reject the application for Parker RV Park, until some issues can be worked out. Another fee will not be charged when it is re-submitted. Commissioner Blacksher seconded the motion. All commissioners voted yes and none no. SEE ATTACHED

A motion was made by **Commissioner Hughes** to approve Tyler County Emergency Management Support for the **Texas Integrated Community Opioid Network (ICON). Commissioner Hudson** seconded the motion. All commissioners voted yes and none no. SEE ATTACHED

A motion was made by Commissioner Marshall and seconded be Commissioner Blacksher to approve the 2025-2026 TAC HEB Agreement. All commissioners voted yes and none no. SEE ATTACHED All commissioners voted yes and none no. SEE ATTACHED

A motion was made by **Commissioner Marshall** to approve the use of **Healthy County reward funds** to be used for employee healthy county projects and incentive prizes, as requested by Leann Monk, Tyler County Treasurer. The motion was seconded by **Commissioner Blacksher.** Mrs. Monk reported \$2800 had been received this year from TAC. She has plans for employees being active in updating flower beds on the square and painting Christmas decorations, etc. All commissioners voted yes and none no. SEE ATTACHED

A motion was made by **Commissioner Marshall** to renew the 2025-2026 **Healthy County Employee Incentive** giving each employee who receives their annual checkup through the Tyler County Hospital Clinic after November 1st, eight hours of sick leave and a reimbursement of \$12.50 (1/2 of their co-pay). The motion was seconded by **Commissioner Hudson.** All commissioners voted yes and none no.

Commissioner Hughes motioned to authorize the opening of a separate interest-bearing investment account for the **hotel occupancy tax collections. Commissioner Marshall** seconded the motion. The County Treasurer stated this will be a dedicated fund that can only be spent on specific items per statute. All commissioners voted yes and none no.

Commissioner Marshall motioned to designate the interest of investment funds of \$440,000 (from a recently closed investment account) to an Employee Benefits Preparedness Account with the intention of preparing for the rising cost of benefits out of the control of court. The motion was seconded by **Commissioner Hudson.** All commissioners voted yes and none no.

A motion was made by **Commissioner Marshall** to allow county employees who qualify for the **\$30 Longevity Reward** to use the benefit to offset out of pocket health care premium costs. The motion was seconded by **Commissioner Hughes.** All commissioners voted yes and none no.

A motion was made by **Commissioner Hughes** and seconded by **Commissioner Blacksher** to approve the **2026 Holiday Schedule**, as presented by the County Treasurer. All commissioners voted yes and none no. SEE ATTACHED

A motion was made by **Commissioner Blacksher** and seconded by **Commissioner Marshall** to authorize Request for Proposals for the **county's annual outside audit.** All commissioners voted yes and none no. SEE ATTACHED
