## I. GHS Collections

Tyler County and i3-Bearcat, LLC (d/b/a Graves, Humphries & Stahl, LTD), hereinafter "GHS", entered into a contract for the collection of delinquent Justice Court fees and fines on April 11, 2022. The Tyler County Commissioners Court voted to terminate the County's agreement on October 14, 2025 with GHS for the collection of delinquent Justice Court fees and fines. This letter serves as notice of the County's termination of the Contract with 90 days-notice as stipulated in paragraph 4. Please take whatever actions are necessary to terminate and wind down GHS's collection efforts.

## II. I3Verticals (Justice of the Peace Case Management Precincts 1, 2, 3, and 4)

Additionally, Tyler County and NET Data Corporation (now "i3verticals, LLC"), hereinafter "i3" entered into a contract November 15<sup>th</sup>, 2007, for a license agreement known collectively as "Justice of the Peace Case Management Precincts 1, 2, 3, and 4" ("Justice of the Peace Software"). On October 14, 2025, the Tyler County Commissioners Court voted to terminate the County's agreement with i3 for the use of Justice of the Peace Software. This letter serves as notice the County's termination of the Justice of the Peace Software on, February 15, 2026. Tyler County hired a new software vendor, and we ask for full cooperation, good faith and fair dealing with obtaining County data for a successful software migration.
