

Courthouse Security Camera Setup

After looking over the camera system at the Tyler County Courthouse I have discovered that there are only four cameras inside the courthouse on the bottom floor and one just outside the Treasurer's. Office on that level. As well as two on the second level in the courtroom lobby.

There are no cameras on the outside or facing the outside of the courthouse other then the ring cameras on the old District Attorney building.

I serving as Courthouse Security believe that more cameras are needed for the safety of the individuals inside the courthouse.


I also believe that a camera under the stairs facing the front lower doorway as well as one facing the upstairs doorway would be in the best interest of safety.

A minimum of six cameras (with a wide view angle) one on each corner and the doorway cameras, would be my recommendation.
