WHEREAS, the 66th Legislature of the State of Texas enacted SB 621, which provides that an Appraisal District be established in each county.

WHEREAS, said Legislature provides for the election of the Board of Directors for the Appraisal District. Each governing body entitled to vote must vote by resolution and submit it to the Chief Appraiser.

WHEREAS, this method of selecting board members was established by Resolution and Ordinance on September 5, 1979.

WHEREAS, on the **9th** day of **February 2026**, the **Tyler County Commissioners Court**, did designate **Tyler County Tax Assessor/Collector, Melissa Carson** as a nominee to the eight member Board of Directors. The motion was adopted.

WHEREAS, a motion was made by _____ and seconded by _____ that the **Tyler County Commissionners Court**, pass the following resolution.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that it is the **Tyler County Commissioners Court's** intent to cast its one vote for **Tyler County Tax Assessor/Collector, Melissa Carson**.
