A motion was made by **Commissioner Marshall** and seconded by **Commissioner Hudson** to approve the **Accounts Payable/County Bills**. All commissioners voted yes none no.

A motion was made by **Commissioner Blacksher** to accept the County Treasurer's December 2025 Monthly report. **Commissioner Marshall** seconded the motion. All commissioners voted yes none no. SEE ATTACHED

Commissioner Blacksher made a motion to authorize County Judge, Milton Powers, to execute the **TXDOT Local Government Assistance Program Agreement**. **Commissioner Marshall** seconded the motion. All Commissioners voted yes none no. SEE ATTACHED

Commissioner Blacksher motioned to consider and approve the new line item named "**Community Outreach/Meals/Meetings**" with a \$2,500.00 budget. Funds will be taken from line-item **076-000-42500 (\$2,000.00)** and line item **076-000-42150 (\$500.00)**. **Judge Powers** commented this was two (2) line items within the emergency management, thus creating a new line-item to help feed the community when needed. The motion was seconded by **Commissioner Marshal**. All commissioners voted yes and none no.

Commissioner Hughes motioned to accept the Resolution to re-appoint **Tyler County Tax Assessor/Collector, Melissa Carson** to the **Tyler County Appraisal District Board of Directors**. The motion was seconded by **Commissioner Marshall**. All commissioners voted yes and none no. SEE ATTACHED

A motion was made by **Commissioner Hughes** to accept re-appointment of **ESD #3 Board Members, Tamberly McCullough** and **Johnny Mitcham**. **Commissioner Blacksher** seconded the motion. All commissioners voted yes none no.

A motion was made by **Commissioner Blacksher** to appoint the new **Veteran's Service Officer, Amy Lambre** and effective as of February 4, 2026. **Commissioner Marshall** seconded the motion. **Commissioner Blacksher** stated that this selection was made from five (5) candidates that were veterans with **Ms. Lambre** having multiple qualifications. All commissioners voted yes none no. SEE ATTACHED

Commissioner Blacksher made a motion to **approve** the **Interlocal Agreement** between the **City of Ivanhoe and Tyler County Precinct 1**, for the exchange of equipment and services. **Commissioner Blacksher** commented that the City of Ivanhoe has a **Gradall** that is too big for their use, with a value of \$12,000.00 and being transferred to precinct 1, in exchange for the use of a reclaimer. **Commissioner Hughes** seconded the motion. A motion was made by **Commissioner Hudson** to approve the purchase of **Kubota M62-111SHDC, 4wd cab, 111 HP** for Commissioner Precinct 4. **Commissioner Marshall** seconded the motion. All commissioners voted yes none no. SEE ATTACHED

A motion was made by **Commissioner Marshall** and seconded by **Commissioner Hudson** to approve the payments of the **Kubota M6S-SHDC, 4wd cab, 111 HP** by lease **Investar Bank**, formally known as First National Bank Wichita Falls. All commissioners voted yes none no.
