A motion was made by **Commissioner Blacksher** and seconded by **Commissioner Hudson** to receive the minutes of March 2, 2026, March 9, 2026, and March 11, 2026. All commissioners voted yes none no.

Budget Amendment/Line-Item Transfer: none

A motion was made by **Commissioner Hughes** and seconded by **Commissioner Marshall** to approve the **Accounts Payable/County Bills**. All commissioners voted yes none no.

A motion was made by **Commissioner Blacksher** to accept the ratification with the amendment to include section 3A special exemption, with a professional pyrotechnic display conducted in conjunction with the Tyler County Dogwood Festival is hereby permitted, provided that the display is conducted by a state licensed pyrotechnic operator. The display is performed, under the direction with direct supervision and written authorization of the Tyler County Fire Marshal, retaining the absolute authority to postpone, cancel, or terminate the display at any time due to the wind speeds, humidity levels, or any other environmental factor deemed a threat to public safety, to the order to prohibit outdoor burning (burn ban) issued on March 23, 2026, with order being in effect until rescinded. **Commissioner Hughes** seconded the motion. All commissioners voted yes none no. SEE ATTACHED

Commissioner Hughes made a motion to restructure the staff salaries and job responsibilities of the **Emergency Operation Center (EOC)**. **Commissioner Blacksher** seconded the motion. All Commissioners voted yes none no.

Commissioners Court
March 30, 2026

Commissioner Hughes motioned to consider/approve enforcing a “no parking” between the signs placed at the airport on the county right-of-way on **County Road 2025**. The motion was seconded by **Commissioner Marshall**. **Commissioner Hughes** commented that the vehicles parking for ball games on the side of the County Road creates a huge safety issue, inhibiting emergency vehicles and mandating a “no parking” would prevent those issues. All commissioners voted yes and none no.

A motion was made by **Commissioner Hudson** to accept the resignation of **Brandon Guillory** as board member of **Emergency Service District (ESD) #2**. **Commissioner Marshall** seconded the motion. All commissioners voted yes none no. SEE ATTACHED

A motion was made by **Commissioner Hudson** to appoint **Rodney Levins** as board member on the **Emergency Service District (ESD) #2** to replace Brandon Guillory. **Commissioner Marshall** seconded the motion. All commissioners voted yes none no. SEE ATTACHED

Commissioner Marshall made a motion for the District Clerk’s office to purchase filing cabinets from **Datum Storage Solutions** in the amount of **\$132,556.43**. **Commissioner Hughes** seconded the motion. **Commissioner Blacksher** confirmed with **Reneé Crews, District Clerk** that approximately \$65,000.00 would be subtracted from the total and the remaining balance would be from the District Clerk’s **Records Preservation Funds, line item 034-000-48010**. All Commissioners voted yes none no. SEE ATTACHED

COMMENTS BY COURT MEMBERS PERTAINING TO MATTERS OF COUNTY GOVERNMENT:

Auditor Jackie Skinner mentioned that there would be a TAC Insurance Presentation during the April, 13, 2026, Commissioner’s Court Meeting.

Commissioner Hudson inquired about the Purple Wave, with Auditor Skinner replying that when list of items that needed to be sold are submitted, a date would be set.

Commissioner Blacksher commented that the Air Show Insurance will be a ten-million-dollar (\$10,000,000.00) policy. The total is \$1,474.00 for the 2026 event, and there is a refund of \$1,192.00 from the 2025 event for a five-million dollar policy, due to last year’s event cancellation, leaving a balance of \$283.00 due.

Treasurer Leann Monk complimented the maintenance department on the revamping of the courthouse lawn.

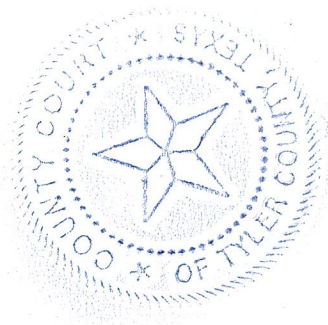
A motion was made by **Commissioner Hudson** and seconded by **Commissioner Blacksher** that the meeting adjourn. All voted yes and none no.
