A motion was made by **Commissioner Marshall** and seconded by **Commissioner Hughes** to accept the **Ratification Declaration for Widespread Flooding filed on June 16, 2026**, and remains in effect until rescinded by the County Judge. **Judge Powers** stated that even though there was no major flooding, some Wildwood homes were flooded. Therefore, the disaster declaration needs to help these homes and a few spots in Warren by extending the declaration to include them in the threshold. All commissioners voted yes none no. Commissioner Hughes motioned to consider/approve the use of **Hotel Occupancy Tax Funds** to purchase needed items for the **250th Birthday Celebration**. Treasurer Leann Monk stated that the statutes are very clear on what the funds can be used for, and one use is for outside events. A motion was made by **Commissioner Marshall** to appoint **Dallas Hatton** as a **Tyler County Representative on the SE Texas Groundwater Conservation District Board of Directors**. **Commissioner Hughes** seconded the motion. All commissioners voted yes none no.

Commissioner Blacksher motioned to accept a **donation for the purchase of fireworks** from the **Read Family** to be dedicated to the **Tyler County America's 250th Birthday Celebration**. **Commissioner Hughes** seconded the motion. **Judge Powers** thanked the Read family for donating \$5,000.00 for the purchase of fireworks. A motion was made by **Commissioner Hughes** and seconded by **Commissioner Marshall** to discuss and act on **Change Order 2 for the GLO Regional MIT HUD MID, GLO Contract No. 24-065-047-E539**. Patrick Oats, with GLS stated that this change order pertains to Precinct 2, County Road 2175 and 2200, and includes replacing old culverts and relocating some mailboxes. All commissioners voted yes none no. SEE ATTACHED

A motion was made by **Commissioner Blacksher** and seconded by **Commissioner Hughes** to discuss and act on **Change Order 4 for the GLO Regional MIT State MID, GLO Contract No. 24-065-046-E538**. Patrick Oates, with GLS stated that there would be no additional cost, just extending the completion date from April 27, 2026, to June 26, 2026. **Commissioner Blacksher** verified that this was for Precinct 4. All commissioners voted yes none no. SEE ATTACHED

A motion was made by **Commissioner Marshall** to accept the **Ratification of Contract Signed with Tetra Tech Inc. for Debris Management Monitoring**. **Commissioner Hudson** seconded the motion. All commissioners voted yes none no. SEE ATTACHED

A motion was made by **Commissioner Marshall** to approve the amendment and billing letter for the **25ALWOODV Airport Project**. **Commissioner Hudson** seconded the motion. **Commissioner Marshall** stated that the project will cost a total of \$49,790.00, with TxDOT Aviation covering 90% and the County paying the remaining 10%. All commissioners voted yes none no. SEE ATTACHED
