

RESOLUTION

A RESOLUTION OF THE COMMISSIONERS COURT OF TYLER COUNTY, TEXAS, AUTHORIZING THE SUBMISSION OF A GRANT APPLICATION TO THE TEXAS GENERAL LAND OFFICE COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT AND REVITALIZATION (GLO-CDR) COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT BLOCK GRANT DISASTER RECOVERY 2024 DISASTERS LOCAL COMMUNITIES PROGRAM; AND AUTHORIZING THE COUNTY JUDGE TO ACT AS THE COUNTY'S EXECUTIVE OFFICER AND THE AUTHORIZED REPRESENTATIVE IN ALL MATTERS PERTAINING TO THE COUNTY'S PARTICIPATION IN THE CDBG DISASTER RECOVERY 2024 DISASTERS LOCAL COMMUNITIES PROGRAM.

WHEREAS, the Commissioners Court of Tyler County, Texas desires to develop a viable community, including decent housing and suitable living environment and expanding economic opportunities, principally for persons of low-to-moderate income, and

WHEREAS, certain conditions exist which represent a threat to the public health and safety; and

WHEREAS, it is necessary and in the best interests of Tyler County, Texas to apply for funding under the Texas General Land Office CDBG 2024 Disasters Local Communities Program;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMISSIONERS COURT OF TYLER COUNTY, TEXAS:

1. **THAT** a CDBG 2024 Disasters Local Communities Program Grant application for the CDBG-24D LCP is hereby authorized to be filed on behalf of the County with the Texas General Land Office.
2. **THAT** the County's application be placed in consideration for funding under the CDBG 2024 Disasters Local Communities Program.
3. **THAT** the application be for \$2,000,000.00 of grant funds to provide for Street Improvements. The County is committing an amount of \$100,000.00 from its General Fund as a cash contribution toward the project.
4. **THAT** the Commissioners Court directs and designates the County Judge as the County's Chief Executive Officer and Authorized Representative to act in all matters in connection with the application and the County's participation in the CDBG 2024 Disasters Local Communities Program.
5. **THAT** all funds will be used in accordance with all applicable federal, state, local and programmatic requirements including but not limited to procurement, environmental review, labor standards, real property acquisition and civil rights requirements.
