Motion was made by Comm. Shepherd, seconded by Comm. Powell to purchase from Robert A. Mann a tract of land containing 1.236 acres in the Jane Taylor League, Tyler County, Texas, and as consideration of same the County will convey a portion of the old roadway, known as Harmony Road, which amounts to 0.300 acres less that which the County wishes to acquire from Mr. Mann and plus ~~200.00~~ ^{200.00} This amount arried at on a value of \$1000.00 per acre and the County to agree to fence the old roadway so that cars cannot pass along it and to build him a fence along the new road which the County will acquire from him. All voted yes, none voted no.

Comm. Fowler made the motion, seconded by Comm. Powell to ask for bids on a car and radio for Sheriff's Dept. Bids to be on a 1970 and alternate bid on 1971 model car. Bids to be opened on August 14, 1970 at 10 A. M. FOR: JORDAN, POWELL AND FOWLER; AGAINST: SHEPHERD.

Motion was made by Comm. Powell, seconded by Comm. Shepherd to employ Clyde E. Smith, Jr., Lawyer, to institute condemnation proceedings to acquire ROW on Highway 287, Precinct #2 and on Highway 60, Precinct No. 1, Tyler County. All voted yes, none voted no.
