Beginning with the intersection of U. S. Highway 190 and U. S. Highway 69 in Woodville.  
Thence north with U. S. 69 to a graded road F. M. Boyett's north line.  
Thence west with said graded road to the east line of R. A. Jernigan's 23 acre tract.  
Thence south to Jernigan's South east corner  
Thence west with road on Jernigan's south line to its conjunction with the Boone's ferry road.  
Thence north with the Boone's ferry road to the Steel's grove road.  
Thence west with the Steel's Grove road to Belt's creek.  
Thence down Belt's creek to Billiams creek. Continue down Billiam's creek to the Neches river.  
Thence east and south with the meanderings of the Neches river to the U. S. Governments "take line" on the west line of dam B lake.  
Thence southerly with said "take line" to Rush creek.  
Then southwesterly with Rush creek to the east line of the David Palmer survey A 504.  
Thence south westerly with the east line of the David Palmer survey to its south east corner and F. M. road 1746.  
Thence west with F. M. road 1746 and U. S. 190 to U. S. 69, the point of beginning.
