Be it known by these presents, that we, Tom Dick Mann, County Judge of Tyler County, Texas, and H. A. Coe, District Judge of 88th Judicial District of Texas, being all the members of the Juvenile Board in Tyler County, Texas, do hereby designate the County Court of Tyler County, Texas, as the Juvenile Court for Tyler County, Texas, as required by Article No. 2338-1, Section No. 4.

Be it further known that the Juvenile Board members as a

body shall investigate, or have investigated all cases coming within the jurisdiction of the Juvenile Court and make recommendations as to what future action may or should be taken.

This order to continue in force and effect until changed by the Juvenile Board as provided by law.
