Gentlemen:

The Citizens State Bank of Woodville, Texas, offers as depository for the County Funds of Tyler County, for the years of 1971-73, and agrees to pay on the County Funds interest on such amounts as may be left on Time Deposit as follows:

On all funds of the County, excepting the School Funds, the Citizens State Bank of Woodville, Texas, agrees to pay interest as above stated at the prevailing Treasury Bill rate at the time of purchase of the Certificate of Deposit, not to exceed five (5%) per cent; and on the School Funds, it also agrees to pay interest on such amounts as may be left on Time Deposit at the prevailing rate of U. S. Treasury Bills at the time of the purchase of the Certificate of Deposit, not to exceed five (5%) per cent.

We enclose as required by law, our Certified Check in the amount of \$600.00 as evidence of our good faith, which is to be returned to us in the event that Citizens State Bank, Woodville, Texas is not selected as depository for the above funds, or after we have made an acceptable bond, in the event we are selected.

The bond to be offered will be the pledge of securities of The United States, The State of Texas, and/or political subdivisions thereof, in such amounts as is required by law.

by law for the next selection of a depository, upon its bidding and agreeing to pay the County of Tyler interest on "time deposits" on daily balances kept in said depository of said County of Tyler at the rate of <sup>Treasury Bill rate not to</sup> exceed 5% per cent per annum, annually. said interest payable ~~monthly~~.

NOW, THEREFORE, if the above bounden pledgor The Citizens State Bank Woodville, Texas shall faithfully do and perform all the duties and obligations devolving on it by law as the county depository of Tyler County, and shall upon presentation pay checks drawn on it by the county treasurer of Tyler County, Texas; on "demand deposits" accounts in such depository; and all checks drawn upon any "time deposit" account upon presentation, after the expiration of the period of notice required in the case of "time deposits," and shall faithfully keep said county funds, and account for same according to law, and shall faithfully keep and account for all funds belonging to the county which are deposited with it under the requirements of Article 2547, Vernon's Annotated Revised Civil Statutes, and shall include State funds collected by the tax collector, and shall pay the interest at the time and at the rate hereinbefore stipulated on "time deposits"; and shall, at the expiration of the term for which it has been chosen, turn over to its successor all the funds, property, and other things of value, coming into its hands as depository, then and in that event this contract is to be and become null and void and the securities above shall be returned to the pledgor, otherwise to remain in full force and effect, hereby specially authorizing the Commissioners' Court of Tyler County, Texas, to sell at public or private sale, with or without notice to the pledgor, the securities, or any part thereof, and apply the proceeds of sale to the satisfaction of any indebtedness arising by virtue of the violation of any or all the conditions of this contract.

The above provision is given in addition to any remedy the pledgee may have in any suit brought on this contract in any court in this State.

Any suit arising out of or in any way connected with this contract, shall be tried in the County of Tyler and State of Texas in any Court therein having jurisdiction of the subject matter thereof.
