At the Regular Meeting of the Tyler County Commissioners Court, held on above date, all members were present. The Meeting was opened by a prayer and Judge Tom D. Mann presided. The following business was taken care of:

Comm Fowler made the motion, seconded by Comm. Jordan, that Mr. & Mrs. Jack Crawford be granted permission to park a Mobile Trailer at the Tyler County Airport and the County to furnish water and electricity. The Contract for same to be drawn up by the County Attorney. All voted yes, none voted no.

Motion was made by Comm Parks, seconded by Comm. Fowler that the bid on Road Grader of Allis Chalmers, Motor Model M-100, Grader-Series B, be accepted, the net bid being \$23,000.00. All voted yes, none voted no. (SEE ATTACHED BIDS).

Motion was made by Comm. Jordan, seconded by Comm. Parks that Sandra Harrison and Luther Owens be deputized in the County Assessor-Collector's Office. All voted yes, none voted no.

Comm. Jordan made the motion, seconded by Comm. Fowler that Dedication Deed on roads be accepted (SEE ATTACHED DEED). And that roads at time of acceptance be cleared of all obstructions. These roads are on the G&BN Survey, Section #8.

Motion by Comm. Jordan, seconded by Comm. Parks that May 18 be declared a Holiday for the Constitutional Amendment Election. All voted yes, none voted no.

Comm. Fowler made the motion, seconded by Comm. Jordan that Joseph C. Nichols, Jr. be granted permission to install water and gas lines to his property along the county roads with following stipulations: (1) That any damage to existing lines or property caused by installation, be the sole responsibility of Mr. Nichols. (2) Any lines that have to be moved at later date be the responsibility of Mr. Nichols, and (3) That all lines be at least 30 inches deep. All voted yes, none voted no.

Comm. Best made the motion, seconded by Comm. Parks that the Court House clock be repaired. All voted yes, none voted no.

Comm. Jordan made the motion, seconded by Comm Parks that the Contract with Wheat, Wheat & Stafford for the collection of delinquent taxes be made a part of the minutes of the Comm. Court. All voted yes, none voted no.

Comm. Parks made the motion that the Activities Report of the County Extension Service be accepted. Comm. Fowler seconded this motion with all voting yes, none voting no.

Comm. Best made the motion, seconded by Comm. Parks that the County Auditor be authorized to pay all current, approved bills. All voted yes, none voted no.

There being no further business, court adjourned.

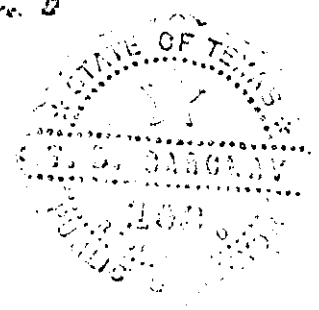


- PLAT -


