

Regular Meeting
Tyler County Commissioners Court
10:00 A. M., June 14, 1971

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At the Regular Meeting of the Tyler County Commissioners Court held on the above date, all members were present. The meeting was opened with a prayer. Judge Tom D. Mann presided and the following business was attended to:

First order of business was to open bids on a truck. Bids were received from Ogden Chev. Co., Colmesneil, Texas; Jack Lane Ford Inc., and A&M Motor Co., Woodville, Texas. Motion by Comm Fowler seconded by Comm Best that the bids on said truck be tabled for further study. (SEE BIDS ATTACHED). All voted yes, none voted no.

Mr. Troy Berry of Southeast Texas R. C. & D. Project spoke to the Court on work of that organization in this area.

Motion was made by Comm. Best seconded by Comm. Parks that the Co. Auditor be authorized to pay all approved bills. All voted yes, none voted no.

Resolution passed. (SEE ATTACHED)

The motion that the County Judge be authorized to sign the deed on Parcel No. 20 to the Texas Highway Department was made by Comm. Jordan, seconded by Comm. Best. All voted yes, none voted no.

Motion by Comm. Parks seconded by Comm. Fowler to accept the Lease with Jack Crawford at the Tyler Co. Airport. (SEE ATTACHED LEASE) All voted yes, none voted no.

Comm. Parks made the motion that the Housing Resolution be approved. (SEE ATTACHED RESOLUTION). Comm. Best seconded this motion and all voted yes, none voted no.

Comm. Fowler made the motion, seconded by Comm. Jordan that the matter of a place to keep livestock picked up by the Stockrider be tabled for further study. All voted yes, none voted no.

Comm. Best made the motion, seconded by Comm Parks that Justice of the Peace E. A. Sturrock be authorized to work out relief on Fee basis until Jan. 1, 1972, then on a salary basis as specified in the Budget. All voted yes, mne voted no.

Court opened bids on land for sale in Colmesneil. Two bids were received, one from J. H. Brown and one from L. P. Horace. Motion by Comm. Fowler, seconded by Comm. Parks to accept the highest bid of \$406.00 from L. P. Horace. All voted yes, none voted no.

Motion was made by Comm. Fowler, seconded by Comm. Parks that the Court accept the bid from A&M Motor Co. on ^{one} truck. (See attached bid/s). All voted yes, none voted no.

Comm. Jordan made the motion, seconded by Comm. Best that Johnny E. Smart of Spurger, Texas be appointed as Justice of the Peace of Pct. #4. All voted yes, none voted no.

There being no further business, court adjourned until next meeting.

The COUNTY OF TYLER AGREES to furnish all utilities to LESSEE and rental thereof in and for the consideration of LESSEE acting as security purposes.
