AUGUST 9, 1971 10:00 o'clock A. M.

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At the Regular Meeting of the Commissioners Court of Tyler County, Texas, held on the above date, all members were present. Judge Tom D. Mann presided, and the meeting was opened with a prayer. The following business was attended to:

Motion was made by Comm. Fowler, seconded by Comm. Parks, to appoint the following persons to the County Housing Authority for the terms indicated:

Comm. Jordan made the motion, seconded by Comm. Best that the Court accept the bid of Mustang Tractor Co. on Motor Grader for Pct. #4. All voted yes, none voted no. (~~SEE~~ ATTACHED BID)

Motion was made by Comm. Best, seconded by Comm. Jordan that the Auditor be authorized to pay all approved bills. All voted yes, none voted no.

Comm. Fowler made the motion, seconded by Comm. Jordan that the Board of County and District Road Indebtedness return surplus funds credited to Tyler County in the amount of \$28,193.70. Such funds are to be used for construction and maintenance of lateral roads in Tyler County. All voted yes, none voted no.

Motion was made by Comm. Best that County Judge Mann be authorized to sign deed for County on Deed to Seneca Water Supply Corporation. Comm. Parks seconded this motion, and all voted yes, none voted no.

Comm. Parks made the motion, seconded by Comm. Best that Jill Ogden be appointed as Deputy in Tax Assessor-Collector's office at a salary of \$288.75 per month. All voted yes, none voted no.

Motion was made by Comm. Jordan, seconded by Comm. Best to approve annual report of Mrs. Mooney and Mr. Currie of the Extension Service. All voted yes, none voted no.

Comm. Best made the motion that signs be purchased and placed at the needed places on County roads showing the speed limit. Comm. Jordan seconded this motion and all voted yes, none voted no.

Comm. Parks made the motion, seconded by Comm. Best to hire two land and timber appraisers at a rate of pay of \$50.00 per day. All voted yes, none voted no.

There being no further business, court adjourned.

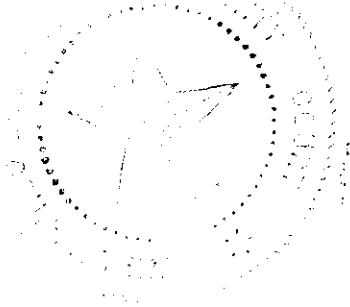
