

TYLER COUNTY COMMISSIONERS COURT
SPECIAL MEETING
NOVEMBER 29, 1971
10:00 A.M.

At the Meeting of the Tyler County Commissioners Court held on the above date, all members were present. The Meeting was opened with a prayer.

A motion was made by Comm. Parks and seconded by Comm. Jordan to authorize the Justice of Peace of Precinct One to attend a School at Texas A & M with expenses paid if not paid by State Grant. The Meeting is to be held December 8, 9, and 10, 1971. All voted yes, none voted no.

A motion was made by Comm. Fowler and seconded by Comm. Parks to discontinue the County Insurance Program January 1, 1972. Comms. Fowler, Parks and Best voted yes, Comm. Jordan abstained. A self insured plan to be implemented by January 1, 1972.

A motion was made by Comm. Jordan and seconded by Comm. Fowler to appoint Judge Mann, County Attorney Brockman and County Auditor Hickman to the Committee to study a revised plan of insurance. All voted yes, none voted no.

A motion was made by Comm. Jordan and seconded by Comm. Parks to set the Tax rate of Special road and bridge districts 1,2,3,4,5 and 6 at 10¢ and County advalorem Value rate at .80, Right of Way Bonds at .13, Farm and lateral roads at .30 and Hospital at .20. All voted yes, none voted no.

A motion was made by Comm. Fowler in order to keep from having a Deficient Budget, that the number of secretaries be reduced in order to cut expenses. Motion died from lack of second.

A motion was made by Comm. Parks and seconded by Comm. Jordan to leave the ratio of Assessment at 15%. All voted yes, none voted no.

There being no further business, the Meeting was adjourned.
