Among other transactions, the following order was passed:

On motion of Commissioner JORDAN, seconded by Commissioner PARK, it is hereby ordered that the Commissioners' Court of Tyler County, Texas, go on record and pass the following resolution:

WHEREAS, the County acquired a Right of Way Easement for the improvement of a public road, now Farm to Market Highway 92, from Emma Dru McMickin by a Dedicatory Instrument dated May 13, 1946 and recorded in Volume 114, Page 568 of the Tyler County Deed Records; and,

WHEREAS, it has become necessary to realign said Farm to Market Highway 92; and,

WHEREAS, a portion of the above referred to Right of Way Easement will no longer be needed for the use of citizens for road purposes upon completion of the highway realignment, said portion being shown in Exhibit "AB", attached hereto and made a part hereof; and,

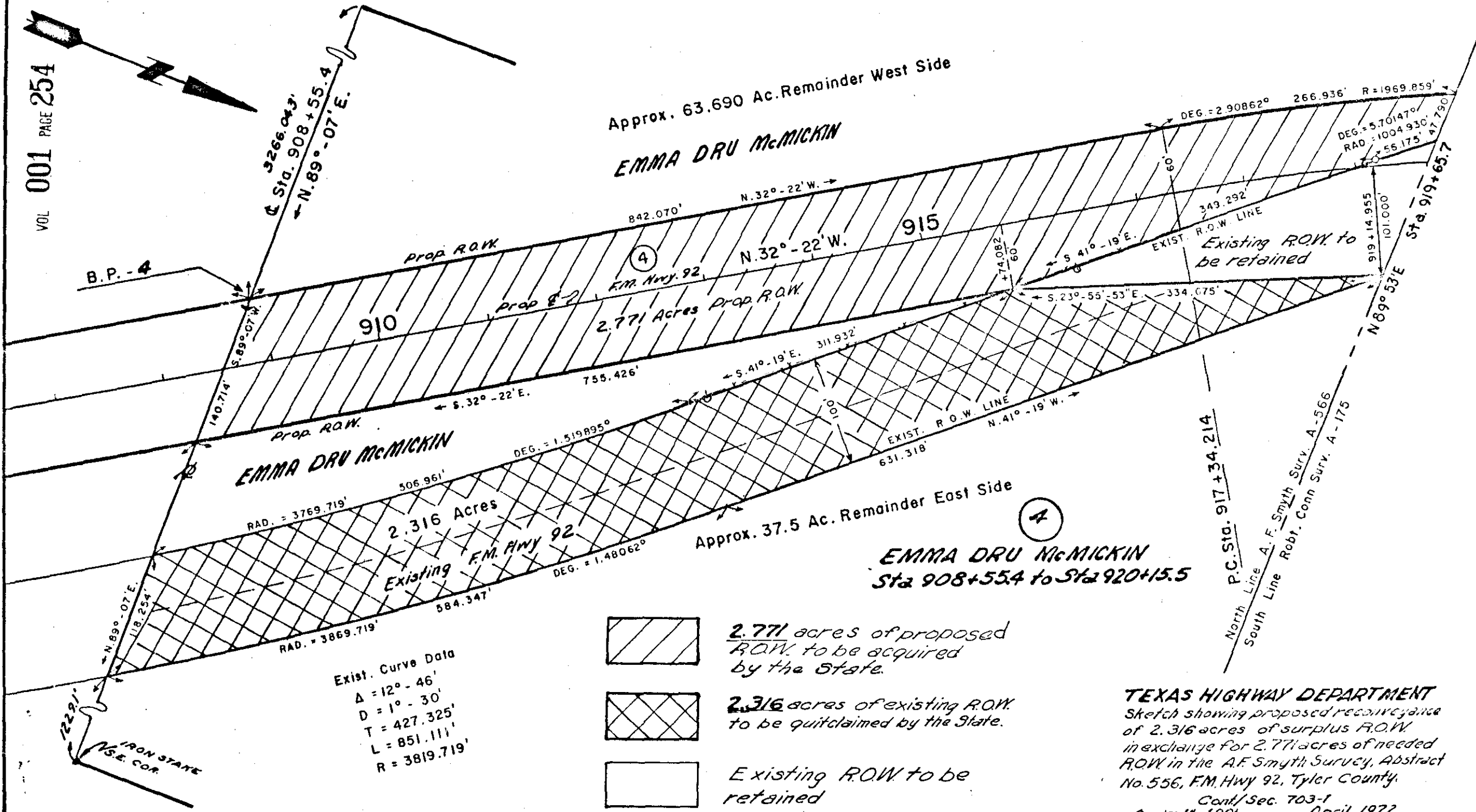
WHEREAS, Tyler County desires to effect an exchange of the aforementioned surplus Right of Way Easement for needed right of way for Farm to Market Highway 92, said needed right of way being also shown in Exhibit "AB" attached hereto and made a part hereof; and,

WHEREAS, there is a monetary difference of \$103.50 between the value of the two tracts of land and Tyler County is willing to pay said amount to Emma Dru McMickin as part consideration for the needed right of way;

NOW, THEREFORE, County Judge Tom Dick Mann is hereby authorized to execute the contract to effect the exchange which will be made upon completion of the highway relocation.

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At the Meeting of the Tyler County Commissioner's Court held on the above date, all members were present. The Meeting was opened with a prayer.

A motion was made by Comm. Fowler and seconded by Comm. Parks to give the County Judge authority to return a months salary figure of \$279.00 per month to BPA. Comms. Fowler, Parks and Best voted yes, Comm. Jordan voted no.

A motion was made by Comm. Jordan and seconded by Comm. Best to publish statutory notice to sell county property of 0.24 an acre in the Josiah Wheat Survey, Abstract 657 at public auction and authorize Tom D. Mann to sell same and execute a deed on behalf of County of Tyler. Sale to be made at 10:00 A.M. Tuesday, May 30th, 1972. Bids to be started at not less than \$10,000.00. All voted yes, none voted no.

A motion was made by Comm. Fowler and seconded by Comm. Jordan to appoint C.E. Poland as Election Judge voting box (Precinct 3) 10 to replace P.F. Maynard. All voted yes, none voted no.

There being no further business the Meeting adjourned.
