WHEREAS, the County acquired a Right of Way Easement for the improvement of a public road, now Farm to Market Highway 92, from Emma Dru McMickin by a Dedicatory Instrument dated May 13, 1946 and recorded in Volume 114, Page 568 of the Tyler County Deed Records; and,

WHEREAS, it has become necessary to realign said Farm to Market Highway 92; and,

WHEREAS, a portion of the above referred to Right of Way Easement will no longer be needed for the use of citizens for road purposes upon completion of the highway realignment, said portion being shown in Exhibit "AB", attached hereto and made a part hereof; and,

WHEREAS, Tyler County desires to effect an exchange of the aforementioned surplus Right of Way Easement for needed right of way for Farm to Market Highway 92, said needed right of way being also shown in Exhibit "AB" attached hereto and made a part hereof; and,

WHEREAS, there is a monetary difference of \$103.50 between the value of the two tracts of land and Tyler County is willing to pay said amount to Emma Dru McMickin as part consideration for the needed right of way;

NOW, THEREFORE, County Judge Tom Dick Mann is hereby authorized to execute the contract to effect the exchange which will be made upon completion of the highway relocation.
