W. J. Taylor to advertise and accept bids for installation of a Refuse Collection System and Sanitary Landfill Equipment until 10:00 A.M. on Friday, June 2, 1972, at the Courthouse, City of Woodville, Tyler County, Texas. The Refuse Collection System to be installed shall consist of a 7,000 pound Loader and 32 cubic yard packer body mounted on a new truck of proper capacity for operation. Hydraulic power for Loader and packer shall be provided from front mounted hydraulic pump. Loader shall have triangle coupler for the handling of containers with triangular couplings. Positive container locks must be provided on Loader for maximum safety. Also such system shall include 120-4 cubic yard containers with three-way split covers. The Sanitary Landfill machine shall be a tractor shovel of at least three cubic yard capacity and weighing at least 42,000 pounds.

All bids shall be in bulk from one supplier for the total package. Individual bids for each item will not be accepted.

The purchase of the Refuse Collection System and Sanitary Landfill Equipment shall be paid for by the issuance and delivery of interest bearing time warrants in an amount not exceeding \$150,000.00 to be authorized by the Commissioners Court on the 2nd day of June, 1972, for the purchase of evidencing the indebtedness of the County of Tyler to be incurred in the purchase of said system and equipment and for all expenses necessary and incidental thereto; said warrants to bear interest at a rate not to exceed 5 and 1/4 per cent per annum and having a maximum maturity date not later than 10 years from their date.

The Commissioner's Court will make arrangements for the successful bidder to dispose of the warrants herein mentioned at not less than par and the successful bidder must agree to deliver warrants at such price to the party with whom the county has made such arrangements.

The county reserves the right to reject any and all bids and to waive all formalities. A copy of the detailed specifications for the Refuse Collection System and Sanitary Landfill Equipment may be obtained at the office of the County Judge of Tyler County, Texas.
