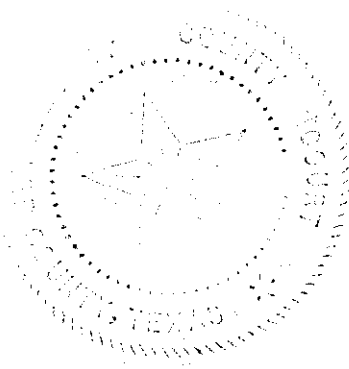



At a meeting of the Board in July the Budget for 1973 was adopted which permits the State to pay all of its required portion of the principal, sinking fund requirement and interest for the year.

It will be necessary that your county raise the amount shown as NET AMOUNT DUE in the "County Portion" column.

Section 6-G of Senate Bill No. 89, Acts of the Regular Session of the Forty-eighth Legislature makes it mandatory upon the county to set a rate sufficient to meet its obligations, and we suggest that a separate rate be levied for each issue.
