At the Meeting of the Tyler County Commissioner's Court held on the above date, all members were present. The Meeting was opened with a prayer.

A motion as made by Comm. Best and seconded by Comm. Parks to pay all authorized bills as approved by the County Auditor. All voted yes, none voted no.

A motion was made by Comm. Fowler and seconded by Comm. Best to accept the Bond of A.G. Thomas as Deputy Constable and also to approve the Deputation of Gaynell Sirmons as Deputy for the Tax Assessor and Collector at a salary of \$288.75 per month. All voted yes, none voted no.

A motion was made by Comm. Jordan and seconded by Comm. Parks to rescind the motion placing the referendum "allowing hunting deer with dogs" on the November Ballot. For rescinding-Comms. Parks, Jordan and Judge Mann, Against rescinding- Comms. Fowler and Best. (Statement by Comm. Fowler-----It was my understanding that if a legal petition was presented to the Court then it was our duty to see that it was placed on the ballot.)

A motion was made by Comm. Jordan and seconded by Comm. Parks to table any action on appointing a J.P. For Pct. #4 until Tuesday September 19, 1972 at 9:30 A.M. All voted yes, none voted no.

A motion was made by Comm. Parks and seconded by Comm. Best to approve the District Clerks office to purchase a long carriage typewriter by bids. All voted yes, none voted no.

There being no further business the Meeting adjourned.
