
TYLER COUNTY COMMISSIONER'S COURT SPECIAL MEETING OCTOBER 23, 1972 10:00 A.M.

A motion was made by Comm. Parks and seconded by Comm. Fowler that the Court go on Record as favoring the hiring of a Special Auditor for the County and that he audit all of the books once a year. All voted yes, none voted no.
