At the Meeting of the Tyler County Commissioner's Court held on the above date, all members were present. The Meeting was opened with a prayer.

A motion was made by Comm. Best and seconded by Comm. Parks to pay all authorized bills as approved by the Auditors office. All voted yes, none voted no.

A motion was made by Comm. Parks and seconded by Comm. Best that the value of the land bordering on RR 255 not be changed on the tax roll because of the completion of the Road so long as the land remains in present use and present owner. This does not keep values from being changed as values of County lands in General are changed. All voted yes, none voted no.

A motion was made by Comm. Fowler and seconded by Comm. Best that up to \$15,000.00 of Revenue Sharing money be allocated and set aside for the County Clerk's office to renew worn Volumes and convert the Records to a microfilm system. All voted yes, none voted no.

A motion was made by Comm. Best and seconded by Comm. Parks to purchase from J.J. Kelley a floor machine for use in the Courthouse. All voted yes, none voted no.

Recessed until 10:00 A.M. Tuesday, November 14, 1972.

A motion was made by Comm. Best and seconded by Comm. Parks to canvass the results of the General Election and the Special Election held in Justice Pct. #4 and that the results be made a part of the minutes. All voted yes, none voted no.

The General Election and the Special Election in Justice Pct.#4 results were canvassed and corrections were made. See attached results.
