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In TYLER COUNTY a FATELTO MARKET ROAD is hereby designated extending from Farm to Market Road 1943, 0.5 mile East of U. S. Highway 69, South a distance of approximately 0.5 mile, subject to the condition that Tyler County will furnish all required right of way clear of obstructions and free of cost to the State and acquisition procedures will be in accordance with applicable Federal and State laws governing the acquisition policies for acquiring real property.

At such time as the County shall accept the provision of this Order and agree to the furnishing of the required right of way, the State . Highway Engineer is directed to proceed with the engineering development, relocation assistance and construction of the project in the most feasible and economical manner, at an estimated cost of \$76,000, and to assume the road for State maintenance upon completion of the construction herein authorized.

This Order is subject to acceptance by the County and if not accepted within 90 days of the date hereof, the action herein contained shall be automatically cancelled.
