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At the meeting of the Tyler County Commissioner's Court held on the above date, all members were present and Judge Mann presided. The Meeting was opened with a prayer.

A motion was made by Comm. Best and seconded by Comm. Belt to adopt resolution regarding supplementing the District Attorney of 88 Judicial District's salary, this resolution makes it possible for counties to supplement salaries. Commissioner's Best, Belt and Judge Mann voted for. Commissioner's Parks and Jordan voted against.

A motion was made by Comm. Jordan and seconded by Comm. Belt to authorize the calling of a County School Board election for the first Saturday in April, 1973. The same being April 7. All voted yes, none voted no.

A motion was made by Comm. Parks and seconded by Comm. Belt to designate the Citizen's State Bank of Woodville according to terms and conditions of the contract dated February 12, 1972 and approved by the Comptroller on February 27, 1973, and attached to the minutes for the Record. All voted yes, none voted no.

A motion was made by Comm. Jordan and seconded by Comm Parks to pay bills that are presented to Court on this date, designating the amount and individuals who are paid by these bills. See attached text. All voted yes, none voted no.

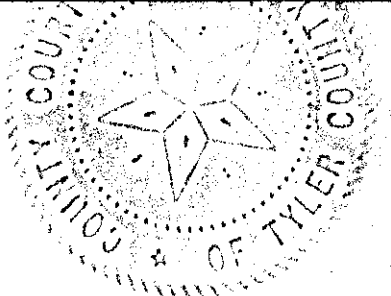
