

TYLER COUNTY COMMISSIONER'S COURT
REGULAR MEETING
JULY 9, 1973
10:00 A.M.

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At the Meeting of the Tyler County Commissioner's Court held on the above date, Comms. Best, Parks, Jordan and Belt were present, Judge Tom Dick Mann was absent. The Meeting was opened with a prayer. Comm. Jordan served as Judge pro-tem.

A motion was made by Comm. Best and seconded by Comm. Parks to take \$765.00 out of Revenue Sharing for the Soil Conservation Local District, if this is not possible, out of the general fund. Comm. Parks and Comm. Best voted yes, Comm. Belt voted no.

A motion was made by Comm. Best and seconded by Comm. Belt to condemn a section of road in N. Allen Survey, 1/3 League, Abstract 38, and return it to its present owner. Easement was given in 1969 and recorded in Volume 255, Page 479, Tyler County Deed Records. All voted yes, none voted no.

A motion was made by Comm. Best and seconded by Comm. Belt to approve payment of monthly bills as submitted and approved by Auditor. All voted yes, none voted no. See attached bills.

A motion was made by Comm. Best and seconded by Comm. Parks to approve expense of Veterans Service Office as submitted. See attached list. All voted yes, none voted no.

A motion was made by Comm. Parks and seconded by Comm. Belt to approve the monthly reports of the County Extension Service. All voted yes, none voted no.

A motion was made by Comm. Belt and seconded by Comm. Best to authorize the County Judge to sign a Resolution with DETC of Government concerning Sheriff's Office. All voted yes, none voted no.

A motion was made by Comm. Best and seconded by Comm. Belt to purchase 3 red visor lights for the County Sheriff's Office to be used and distributed by Sheriff. Comm. Best and Belt for, Comm. Parks abstained.

A motion was made by Comm. Parks and seconded by Comm. Best to recess until 10:00 A.M. Thursday, July 12, 1973. All voted yes, none voted no.

The Meeting of the Tyler County Commissioner's Court resumed on Thursday, July 12, 1973 at 10:00 A.M. Judge Mann and Comms. Parks and Best were present, Comms. Jordan and Belt were absent. The Meeting opened with a prayer.

A motion was made by Comm. Parks and seconded by Comm. Best to pay Ann Fondren for overtime working on budget. All voted yes, none voted no.

A motion was made by Comm. Best and seconded by Comm. Parks to authorize the County Judge to sign a Resolution for the Deep East Texas Council of Governments concerning the Texas Highway Commission and a Resolution concerning a Mental Health Center. All voted yes, none voted no.

There being no further business the Meeting adjourned.


WHEREAS, the County of TYLER has been in full support of the Texas Highway Department and has worked with that Agency on many successful road projects and,

WHEREAS, the County of TYLER wishes to recognize the Texas Highway Department for its fine work and National Highway Week, and,


WHEREAS, the County of TYLER is a member of the thirteen (13) County Deep East Texas Council of Governments.
