At the regular meeting of the Tyler County Commissioner's Court held on the above date and time, all members were present. The Meeting opened with a prayer.

A motion was made by Comm. Best and seconded by Comm. Belt to grant Arthur G. Gilchrest the authority to purchase necessary paint to paint signs on garbage containers. All voted yes, none voted no.

A motion was made by Comm. Parks and seconded by Comm. Jordan to approve the tax roll forms number 16 and 18 for 1973 tax roll. All voted yes, none voted no.

A motion was made by Comm. Parks and seconded by Comm. Belt to approve the monthly bills for payment as submitted and approved by the Auditors Office. All voted yes, none voted no.

A motion was made by Comm. Parks and seconded by Comm. Belt to issue three (3) time warrants in the amount of \$5,000.00 each to come due in December 1974, December 1975 and December 1976 to pay for a Frond-End Loader for Precinct 2. All voted yes, none voted no.

A motion was made by Comm. Belt and seconded by Comm. Jordan to adopt a resolution concerning the Big Thicket National Park. See attached resolution. All voted yes, none voted no.

A motion was made by Comm. Best and seconded by Comm. Belt to pay the employees of County a \$50.00 Christmas Cost of Living Bonus. All voted yes, none voted no.

A motion was made by Comm. Best and seconded by Comm. Belt to authorize the Auditors Office to transfer back to the General Fund \$5,912.70, from Revenue Sharing, which was paid out of the General Fund for the Sheriff's car. Commissioners Best, Belt and Jordan voted yes, Comm. Parks abstained.

A motion was made by Comm. Best and seconded by Comm. Parks to approve the monthly report of the Extension Service. All voted yes, none voted no.

A motion was made by Comm. Parks and seconded by Comm. Belt to pay \$43.00 hospital bill of Jesse Mangum at Galveston Hospital. All voted yes, none voted no.

A motion was made by Comm. Jordan and seconded by Comm. Belt to accept the bid of Ogden Chevrolet Co. of \$4582.60 for a for a new truck for Precinct 4. See attached bids. All voted yes, none voted no.

A motion was made by Comm. Jordan and seconded by Comm. Belt to approve a policy for employees to work during their vacation and be paid for same instead of being a replacement. All voted yes, none voted no.

A motion was made by Comm. Best and seconded by Comm. Parks to authorize the Justice of the Peace of Precinct 1 to hire a secretary starting December 15th, 1973 at regular deputy salary. All voted yes, none voted no.

A motion was made by Comm. Jordan and seconded by Comm. Belt to authorize the Sheriff's Office to place the extra radar set in Arthur G. Gilchriest's patrol car. All voted yes, none voted no.

There being no further business, the Meeting adjourned.

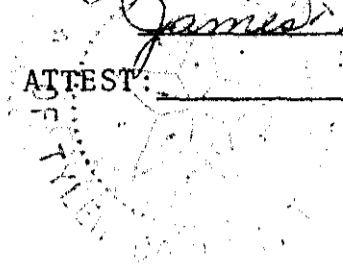

the following absent, None, thereby constituting a quorum, when among other things, the following proceedings had, the following orders were passed, to-wit:

Upon the motion of Commissioner Belt and a second by Commissioner Jordan and the unanimous vote of the Court do hereby adopt the following Resolution.

RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, The National Park Service recommended in May, 1967, the establishment of a 35,500 acre "string of pearls" Big Thicket National Monument in Southeast Texas to preserve the unique ecology and historically interesting characteristics of the area; and

WHEREAS, use and development of land already owned by the Federal Government should be of primary consideration in planning for the Big Thicket Park or Monument, with the purchase of additional lands from private landowners secondary; and

WHEREAS, the economic progress of Texas is, to a great extent, dependent upon our forest resources which supply the materials to help build our homes, schools, churches, towns and cities, which would be substantially reduced by creating a Big Thicket Park of more than 35,500 contained acres; and

WHEREAS, countless forest products are required to improve the standard of living, and furnish compensation of this and future generations;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Commissioners Court of Tyler County, Texas opposes the establishment of a Big Thicket Biological and Botanical Preserve of more than 35,500 contained acres; and

BE IT RESOLVED, that no homes be taken; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that no river, bayou or creek corridors be taken.

WHEREUPON, Court stands recessed.




