Best that due to an emergency created by the energy crisis it is necessary to amend the fuel agreement made with Bruce Conner to allow the following increase in prices: Premium gasoline 32¢ per gallon, regular gasoline 30¢ per gallon and Diesel gasoline 27¢ per gallon. All voted yes, none voted no.

A motion was made by Comm. Best and seconded by Comm. Belt to purchase a new radar unit for the State Highway Patrol. All voted yes, none voted no.

A motion was made by Comm. Belt and seconded by Comm. Best to authorize the County Judge to sign a Resolution concerning Water and Sewer Grants. See attached resolution. All voted yes, none voted no.

A motion was made by Comm. Jordan and seconded by Comm. Best to pay the bills as submitted and approved by the County Auditor. See attached bills. All voted yes, none voted no.

A motion was made by Comm. Best and seconded by Comm. Belt to advertise for bids on adding a 26' X 30' addition to the County Tax Office. Bids to be opened January 14, 1974 at 10:00 A.M. All voted yes, none voted no.
