A motion was made by Comm. Best and seconded by Comm. Belt to approve the number of employees in each office and leave the same until any further requests are made. See attached list. All voted yes, none voted no.

A motion was made by Comm. Parks and seconded by Comm. Best to approve the monthly bills as submitted by the County Auditor. All voted yes, none voted no. See attached bills.

A motion was made by Comm. Parks and seconded by Comm. Belt to set the expense accounts for officials, car allowance, the same as last year, \$25.00. All voted yes, none voted no.

A motion was made by Comm. Parks and seconded by Comm. Best to set the terms for County Court quarterly, in four terms. 1st term-- January, February, March, 2nd term--April, May, June 3rd term-- July August, September, 4th term--October, November December. All voted yes, none voted no.

A motion was made by Comm. Parks and seconded by Comm. Belt to appoint Joe Best as Airport Manager. All voted yes, none voted no.

A motion was made by Comm. Best and seconded by Comm. Jordan to appoint Tom D. Mann as Courthouse Manager. All voted yes, none voted no.

A motion was made by Comm. Belt and seconded by Comm. Parks to approve the payment of \$25.00 to the Rural Fire Departments, and to pay back pay to the Warren Rural Fire Department from the time they became active until this month. All voted yes, none voted no.

A motion was made by Comm. Belt and seconded by Comm. Parks to appoint a Grievance Committee. The members of this Committee are as follows: Non-Voting Chairman--Tom Dick Mann, County Judge, All elected officials, excluding Commissioners, Mrs. R.E. Allison, C.A. Williams, and Clifford C. Hall. All voted yes, none voted no.

A motion was made by Comm. Belt and seconded by Comm. Parks to approve the Veterans Affairs Annual Report. All voted yes, none voted no.

A motion was made by Comm. Belt and seconded by Comm. Jordan to renew the contract of Irene Amacker for the prisoners meal, at the same price as last year. All voted yes, none voted no.

A motion was made by Comm. Best and seconded by Comm. Belt not to renew the contract of Wheat, Wheat, and Stafford as attorneys for Delinquent Tax Collections, at Wheat, Wheat, and Staffords request. All voted yes, none voted no.

A motion was made by Comm. Best and seconded by Comm. Belt to appoint Dr. John Gilchrist as the County Health Officer at \$100.00 a month. All voted yes, none voted no.

A motion was made by Comm. Best and seconded by Comm. Belt to authorize the tax collector to advertise for bids on preparing the tax roll. All voted yes, none voted no.

A motion was made by Comm. Belt and seconded by Comm. Jordan to allocate \$10,000.00 to each Commissioner out of the Revenue Sharing Entitlement 5 check and cash \$20,000.00 of Certificate of Deposits and transfer to the checking account. All voted yes, none voted no.

A motion was made by Comm. Best and seconded by Comm. Parks to approve the reports of the County Extension Agents. All voted yes, none voted no.

A motion was made by Comm. Jordan and seconded by Comm. Best to appoint Jimmy Reid as Deputy Constable of Precinct #4 at no expense to the County. All voted yes, none voted no.

A motion was made by Comm. Jordan and seconded by Comm. Belt to approve the \$3,000.00 tax exemption for persons 65 and over. All voted yes, none voted no.

A motion was made by Comm. Best and seconded by Comm. Jordan to table for further study a motion to raise the travel expenses of the County Extension Service to \$1,600.00. All voted yes, none voted no.

A motion was made by Comm. Jordan and seconded by Comm. Belt to reject bids for the Tax Office addition at the recommendation of the County Attorney. All voted yes, none voted no.

A motion was made by Comm. Best and seconded by Comm. Belt to accept the bid of George P. Bane, Inc. of \$34,000.00 for a new Allis-Chalmers Model 100 Series C Motor Grader for Precinct #1. Time warrants to be issued. See attached bid. All voted yes, none voted no.

A motion was made by Comm. Parks and seconded by Comm. Jordan to approve the bonds of Ernest Herndon and Donald Wayne Woodrome as Deputy Constables. All voted yes, none voted no.

A motion was made by Comm. Parks and seconded by Comm. Best to accept the recommendation of the County Auditor to accept the low bid of \$6,840.00 from the National Cash Register Co., for an Accounting machine. This is to be paid in 3 installments out of Revenue Sharing. See attached bids. All voted yes, none voted no.

A motion was made by Comm. Belt and seconded by Comm. Jordan to approve the allocation to the Probation Department for 1974. All voted yes, none voted no.

A plan that was submitted by Jim Dillion was discussed and tabled for further study.

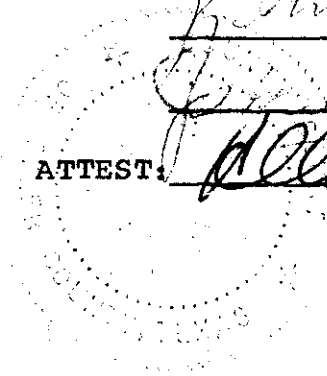
A motion was made by Comm. Parks and seconded by Comm. Jordan to declare the following days as Holidays for the County:
