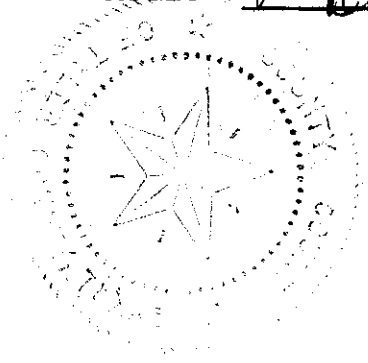
A motion was made by Comm. Jordan and seconded by Comm. Best to approve monthly report of County Extension Agents. All voted yes, none voted no.
