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TYLER COUNTY COMMISSIONER'S COURT  
REGULAR MEETING  
JUNE 10, 1974  
10:00 A.M.

At the regular Meeting of the Tyler County Commissioner's Court held on the above date and time, all members were present. The Meeting opened with a prayer.

A motion was made by Comm. Jordan and seconded by Comm. Belt to approve the application of Margie Landers, Patricia Brown and Allen Sturrock to attend the County and District Clerk's State Convention in Amarillo, June 26-28 and to pay their expenses. All voted yes, none voted no.

A motion was made by Comm. Parks and seconded by Comm. Best to advertise to sell a 4 room frame house of Jim Hensarling in Doucette, in right-of-way of farm road #1632. Bids to be opened on June 28, 1974 at 10:00 A.M. Successful bidder to move house within 90 days of purchase. The County reserves the right to refuse any or all bids. All voted yes, none voted no.

A motion was made by Comm. Best and seconded by Comm. Jordan to approve the bond of R.A. Jernigan as an independent Public Weigher for a 2 year term beginning July 15, 1974. All voted yes, none voted no.

A motion was made by Comm. Best and seconded by Comm. Jordan to accept the monthly reports of the County Extension Service. All voted yes, none voted no.

A motion was made by Comm. Parks and seconded by Comm. Best to approve the monthly bills as submitted and approved by the Auditor. All voted yes, none voted no. See attached bills.

A motion was made by Comm. Jordan and seconded by Comm. Best to approve for filing purposes only the plat of Ponderosa Garden Subdivision with the restrictions as recorded and approved by State Health Department. See attached resolution. All voted yes, none voted no.

A motion was made by Comm. Jordan and seconded by Comm. Belt to approve paying the vacations and to continue letting the Solid Waste crews work. All voted yes, none voted no.

A motion was made by Comm. Belt and seconded by Comm. Jordan to order a new motor for the Ford Truck used in Solid Waste Disposal Work. All voted yes, none voted no.

A motion was made by Comm. Jordan and seconded by Comm. Best to re-appoint L.P. Hicks, Carl Fairchild and J.B. (Toby) Spurlock each to a two year term to the Tyler County Hospital Board. All voted yes, none voted no.

A motion was made by Comm. Jordan and seconded by Judge Mann to approve the payment to Pat Brown at a rate of 15¢ per mile and meals on submitted bills to attend the Regional Planning Meeting. All voted yes, none voted no.

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
