"Whereas. the Texas Legislature has established the Texas County and District Retirement System, pursuant to Section 62 of Article XVI of the Texas Constitution; and

Whereas, said constitutional provision directs that the governing body shall determine whether the County shall participate in the System so established; and

Whereas, this Commissioners Court has determined that it is to the public interest that the County of <u>Tyler</u> participate in the System,

for the purpose of more adequately providing for retirement of superannuated or disabled employees; it is therefore

 In this order, the respective terms 'deposits', 'employee', 'earnings'.
 'prior service', 'service', and 'System' have the meanings defined for such term by Chapter 127, Acts, Regular Session, 60th Legislature of Texas.

2. Pursuant to the provisions of Chapter 127, Acts, Regular Session, 60th Legislature, <u>Tyler</u> County hereby elects to participate in, and to have its employees¹ participate in the Texas County and District Retirement System, such participation to begin and be effective on the first day of <u>March</u>, <u>19</u> 75.

3. All persons who are employees of said County on the effective date of participation prescribed above shall become members of the System and shall be allowed credit for prior service in accordance with the provisions of said Act and the Rules and Regulations of the Board of Trustees of the System. Each person who shall become an employee of the County subsequent to the effective date of participation and who is not already a member of the System, shall become a member at date of his employment, provided he shall at such date be less than sixty (60) years of age.

4. Each employee of <u>Tyler</u> County shall make deposits to the System for each payroll period at the rate of <u>7%</u> per centum $(7\%)^2$

of earnings, which deposits shall be withheld by the <u>County Auditor</u> ³ from the compensation of the employee, in accordance with the Subsection 1, Section IV of the act above mentioned.⁴

5. The County shall make benefit contributions to the System in an amount which for each payroll period is equal to the sum of deposits made to the System by all of its employees for such period.

If the Court desires to limit the amount of earnings on which contributions (and resultant benefits) are calculated, add to the sentence, after the word "montioned" the following: "provided, however, that annual earnings of any employee in excess of <u>per year</u>, or which for any calendar month exceeds one-twelfth (1712th) of said annual maximum, shall be excluded in calculating the deposits permitted by or required of such employee." The annual maximum, if one is prescribed, must be some multiple of \$1, 200, but may not be less than \$3,600.
