At the Meeting of the Tyler County Commissioner's Court held on the above date and time opened with a prayer. All members were present.

A motion was made by Comm. Jordan and seconded by Comm. Belt to accept the bid of Citizen State Bank for the County Depository for 1975-76. See attached contract. All voted yes, none voted no.

A motion was made by Comm. Jordan and seconded by Comm. Best to authorize Raymond Pope to push dirt and level the East side of the airport. All voted yes, none voted no.

A motion was made by Comm. Jordan and seconded by Comm. Best to extend the contract with the Probation Department and to fund it out of Revenue Sharing in the amount of \$3,300.00 for the next 3 months starting April 1, 1975. All voted yes, none voted no.

A motion was made by Comm. Belt and seconded by Comm. Best to pay bills as submitted and approved by the Auditor's office. See attached copy. All voted yes, none voted no.

A motion was made by Comm. Best and seconded by Comm. Belt to accept the monthly report of the County Extension Service. All voted yes, none voted no.

A motion was made by Comm. Best and seconded by Comm. Belt to appoint Ann Fondren as Assistant Auditor and that her salary be increased \$1,000.00 per year, with this increase coming out of the Auditor's salary, to be effective March 1, 1975. All voted yes, none voted no.

A motion was made by Comm. Best and seconded by Comm. Belt to appoint Austin Fuller as Civil Defense Director for Tyler County. All voted yes, none voted no.

A motion was made by Comm. Parks and seconded by Comm. Belt to transfer the payroll duties to the Treasurer's office from the Auditor's office. All voted yes, none voted no.

A motion was made by Comm. Jordan and seconded by Comm. Belt to accept the monthly report of the Treasurer's office. See attached copy. All voted yes, none voted no.

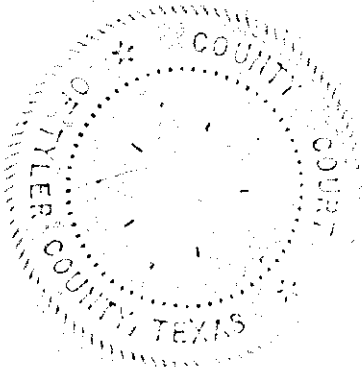

R E S O L U T I O N

DESIGNATION OF DEEP EAST TEXAS COUNCIL OF GOVERNMENTS AS AGENT FOR THE COUNTY OF TYLER, TEXAS FOR THE PURCHASE OF CERTAIN RADIO EQUIPMENT.

WHEREAS, said County has participated in the purchase, installation and maintenance of a regional communications system; and

WHEREAS, it is necessary that additional radio communications equipment be purchased in order to fully utilize and complement the communications system;

BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED THAT:

Said County purchase the radio and communications equipment set forth and described in Exhibit "A", attached and incorporated hereto, at the price and quantity set forth therein; the total purchase price shall not exceed \$1,808.50 for the acquisition and installation of said radio communications equipment;

The Deep East Texas Council of Governments is hereby appointed, designated and made the true and lawful agent for the special purpose of purchasing the said equipment described hereinafter, and to act in the said County's behalf in taking all steps necessary to the accomplishment of the purchase, installation and operation of the said radio communications system;

The Deep East Texas Council of Governments is hereby empowered, but not limited, to enter into contract on behalf of the said County as may be necessary to purchase said radio communications equipment, and to employ or engage the services of any party where such services are reasonably necessary for accomplishing the purposes set forth in this resolution;


Any police radio communications equipment sold or disposed of during the project period shall have those revenues or the value thereof applied as project income as per Law Enforcement Assistance Administration policy;

This body, as representative of Tyler County, Texas, upon acquisition and purchase of said communication equipment and related accessories, will include said equipment in its permanent inventory where applicable, and will upon receipt of said equipment execute a release in favor of the Deep East Texas Council of Governments, releasing it from all liability in connection with said project.



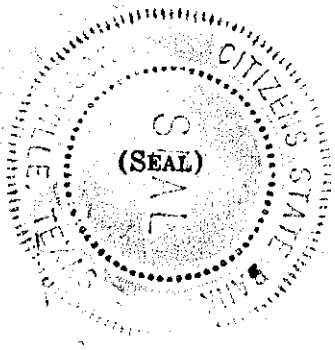

The above provision is given in addition to any remedy the pledgee may have in any suit brought on this contract in any court in this State.

Any suit arising out of or in any way connected with this contract, shall be tried in the County of Tyler and State of Texas in any Court therein having jurisdiction of the subject matter thereof.

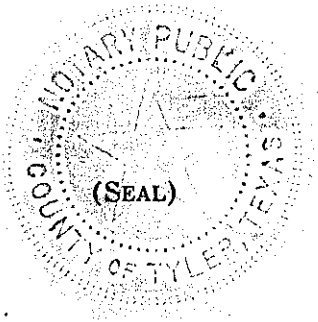
