

The Deep East Texas Council of Governments is hereby appointed, designated and made the true and lawful agent for the special purpose of purchasing the said equipment described hereinafter, and to act in the said County's behalf in taking all steps necessary to the accomplishment of the purchase, installation and operation of the said radio communications system;

The Deep East Texas Council of Governments is hereby empowered, but not limited, to enter into contract on behalf of the said County as may be necessary to purchase said radio communications equipment, and to employ or engage the services of any party where such services are reasonably necessary for accomplishing the purposes set forth in this resolution:

Any police radio communications equipment sold or disposed of during the project period shall have those revenues or the value thereof applied as project income as per Law Enforcement Assistance Administration policy;

This body, as representative of Tyler County, Texas, upon acquisition and purchase of said communication equipment and related accessories, will include said equipment in its permanent inventory where applicable, and will upon receipt of said equipment execute a release in favor of the Deep East Texas Council of Governments, releasing it from all liability in connection with said project.
