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At the Meeting of the Tyler County Commissioner's Court held on the above date and time, all members were present. The Meeting opened with a prayer.

A motion was made by Commissioner Best and seconded by Commissioner Parks that the court accept the road in Warren as a County road that is described in the petition attached. Since this road has been maintained by the County for the past 10 years. All voted yes, and none voted no.

A motion was made by Commissioner Parks and seconded by Commissioner Jordan that the salary of Mrs. Billie Jean Broom was \$50.00 per month when she was elected and that the Court continue to pay her the same salary at \$50.00 per month until further action of the Court. All voted yes, none voted no.

A motion was made by Commissioner Parks and seconded by Commissioner Belt to approve the report of the County Extension Service. All voted yes, none voted no.

A motion was made by Commissioner Parks and seconded by Commissioner Best to table the question of the air-condition of the Parks and Wildlife. All voted yes, none voted no.

A motion was made by Commissioner Best and seconded by Commissioner Belt to table the question of the entitlement of the Reveune Sharing of 1976. All voted yes, none voted no.

A motion was made by Commissioner Best and seconded by Commissioner Parks to authorize the assistant auditor to attend the annual auditors meeting in Austin in May and to pay the expenses in advance. All voted yes, none voted no.

AGREEMENT FOR DATA PROCESSING SERVICES:

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WHEREAS, Western Data Services, Inc., is engaged in rendering special data processing, including services to taxing units and others, and the undersigned desires to contract for its services upon the consideration and terms hereinafter stated, to wit:

WESTERN DATA SERVICES, INC., of Ellis County, Texas, agrees to perform the following services and supply all necessary tax forms for TYLER COUNTY and for the years 1972 and subsequent years, to wit:

- Tax Roll (4 copies, 1 bound temporary)
- Tax Receipts (3 copies)
- Tax Statement (1 copy)
- Property Inventory (2 copies)
- Proof List
- October through January Monthly Reports - \$.04 per receipt listed

This agreement shall be considered in force and effect unless notice of termination is submitted in writing to either party by October 1st for each successive year.

Western Data Services, Inc. agrees to supply the pickup and delivery service that is necessary to perform the work above described, and will deliver the above mentioned reports in condition ready for binding, unless otherwise directed by the tax assessor. In the event binding service, other than those set out above, is required by the taxing authority, a charge for binding will be made, which shall be in addition to the charges set out below.

The tax office will receive a proof roll upon completion of the keypunching by Western Data Services, Inc., and the tax office will be responsible for making the necessary changes to this proof roll to conform to its correct tax records, and will make the corrected roll available to Western Data Services, Inc. no later than July 15th of each tax year. Upon receipt of said corrected proof roll Western Data Services, Inc. guarantees to deliver all of the services required no later than September 20th of each tax year. If the corrected proof roll is not delivered until after July 15th, then an equal number of days will be allowed Western Data Services, Inc. to complete delivery of its services.

In consideration for the rendition of the above services, exclusive of special binding service, charges shall be computed and paid for on the basis of \$.18 per line item of the tax roll.


