REGULAR MEETING
JUNE 9th, 1975
10:00 a.m.

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At the Meeting of the Tyler County Commissioner's Court held on the above date and time, all members were present. The Meeting opened with a prayer.

A motion was made by Commissioner Jordan and seconded by Commissioner Parks to accept plat of subdivision inside City of Woodville, designated as Timberland Estates, Plat File #185 for recording purposes only. All voted yes, none voted no.

A motion was made by Commissioner Parks and seconded by Commissioner Best to authorize payment of \$100.00 in funeral expenses of Ervie Kiel who passed away at Rusk. All voted yes, none voted no.

A motion was made By Commissioner Jordan and seconded by Commissioner Belt to authorize Austin Fuller as Civil Defense Director to purchase surplus equipment for the office of Justice of Peace Pct. #3. All voted yes, none voted no.

A motion was made by Commissioner Best and seconded by Commissioner Belt to advertise for bids to mow the Tyler County Airport one time. Bids to be approved 10:00 a.m. on July 14th, 1975. All voted yes, none voted no.

A motion was made by Commissioner Parks and seconded by Commissioner Belt to authorize the County Attorney to move his office out of the Courthouse to his office at 409 South Magnolia Street Woodville, Texas and to continue to furnish him with a secretary. All voted yes, none voted no.

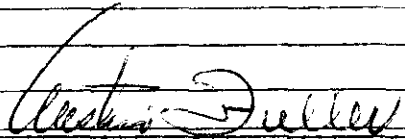

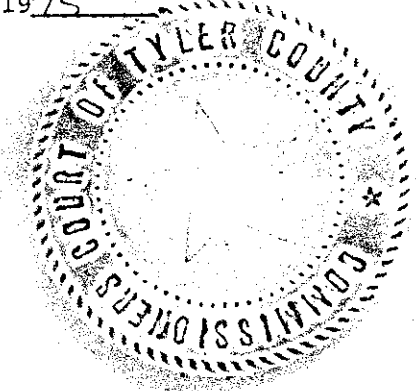
