At the Meeting of the Tyler County Commissioner's Court held on the above date and time, all members were present. The Meeting opened with a prayer.

A motion was made by Commissioner Parks and seconded by Commissioner Jordan that regular employed dispatches who work on legal county holidays be paid double time for the days work. All voted yes, none voted no.

A motion was made by Commissioner Jordan and seconded by Commissioner Parks to appoint the following officials to the Board of Directors of the Deep East Texas Council of Governments: District Clerk Patricia Brown, Judge Tom D. Mann, Commissioner Kenneth Belt and Sheriff Lewis Craven and alternate Commissioner James R. Jordan and that Judge Tom D. Mann be appointed to the executive Committee of D.E.T.C. of Government. All voted yes, none voted no.

A motion was made by Commissioner Best and seconded by Commissioner Parks to do away with the County wide Garbage Collection System. For, Best and Parks; against, Mann, Belt, and Jordan.

A motion was made by Commissioner Parks and seconded by Commissioner Belt to approve payments of bills as submitted and approved by the auditor. All voted yes, none voted no.

A motion was made by Judge Mann and seconded by Commissioner Belt to continue to participate in the Mental Health and Mental Retardation program as it is now set up. All voted yes, none voted no.

A motion was made by Commissioner Parks and seconded by Commissioner Best to allocate Entitlement #5 4th quarter Revenue Sharing of \$42,276.00 as follows: \$15,000.00 to Solid Waste, Tax Office, \$10,500.00; Allan Shivers Library, \$2,500.00; and each Commissioner Pct., \$3,569.00 and that the Library be allocated \$2,500.00 out of each quarter. All voted yes, none voted no.

A motion was made by Commissioner Belt and seconded by Commissioner Parks to accept bid of Lufkin Typewriter Co. on servicing the County office machines. See attached bids. All voted yes, none voted no.

A motion was made by Commissioner Belt and seconded by Commissioner Best to approve the recommendations of the County Tax Assessor to continue to use Western Data to prepare the voters registration list. All voted yes, none voted no.

A motion was made by Commissioner Belt and seconded by Commissioner Best to approve the Treasures Report for June 1975. See attached report. All voted yes, none voted no.

A motion was made by Commissioner Belt and seconded by Commissioner Best to authorize the County Auditor to purchase necessary paint to paint the inside of the Auditor's office. All voted yes, none voted no.

A motion was made by Commissioner Best and seconded by Commissioner Jordan to approve the budget report of the County Extension Service. All voted yes, none voted no.

A motion was made by Commissioner Best and seconded by Commissioner Jordan to accept the bid of Joe Hensarling of \$475.00 to mow the Tyler County Airport one time. See attached bid. All voted yes, none voted no.

A motion was made by Commissioner Best and seconded by Commissioner Belt to accept the bid of Melvin Davidson in the amount of \$745.95 to renovate and shelve the two downstairs rooms, making them into storage areas. See attached bids. All voted yes, none voted no.

All voted yes, none voted no.

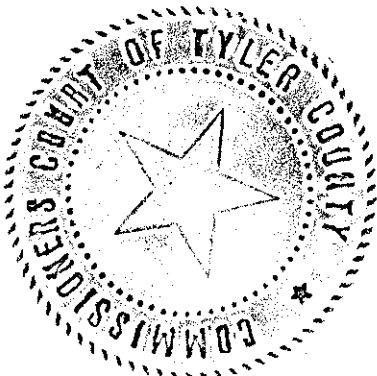
