The regular meeting of the Commissioner's Court of Tyler County met on August 11, 1975 at 10:00 AM. All were present and the meeting opened with a prayer.

The motion was made by Commissioner Best and seconded by Commissioner Belt that Oona Ogden, Johnny Harris and Morris Clemmons, Jr. be reappointed to a two (2) year term on the Board of Directors of Tyler County Hospital. All members voted yes and none voted no.

The motion was made by Commissioner Jordan and seconded by Commissioner Parks to approve the amendment by Coastal Timber Growers, Inc. to Plat File 185 and 185 A and that it be designated 185 B. This approval is for filing purposes only. All members voted yes and none voted no.

The motion was made by Commissioner Parks and seconded by Commissioner Belt that the County request the Board of County and District Road Indebtedness to return to Tyler County its share of lateral road surplus funds in the amount of \$28,193.70 to be used on lateral roads in Tyler County. See attached letter. All voted yes and none voted no.

Commissioner Best made a motion to approve the bills as submitted by the County Auditor. This was seconded by Commissioner Belt. All members voted yes and none voted no. See attached bills.

Commissioner Belt made the motion to approve the County Treasurer's report for July 1975. This was seconded by Commissioner Best. All voted yes and none voted no. See attached report.

The motion was made by Commissioner Jordan and seconded by Commissioner Belt to authorize the County Auditor to have their office painted. All voted yes and none voted no.

Commissioner Parks made the motion to delay the opening of bids on a motor grader for Precinct 2 until 10:00 AM on August 31, 1975. This motion was seconded by Commissioner Belt. All voted yes and none voted no.

Since there was no further business, the meeting adjourned.
