

TYLER COUNTY COMMISSIONER'S COURT
REGULAR MEETING
OCTOBER 13, 1975
10:00 A.M.

At the Meeting of the Tyler County Commissioner's Court held on the above date, all members were present except Commissioner Jordan and the Meeting was opened with a prayer.

A motion was made by Commissioner Parks and seconded by Commissioner Best to approve County Treasurer's report for the month of September. See attached copy. All voted yes, none voted no.

A motion was made by Commissioner Parks and seconded by Commissioner Belt to approve payment of bills as submitted and approved by County Auditor. See attached copy. All voted yes, none voted no.

A motion was made by Commissioner Best and seconded by Commissioner Belt to approve and pay expenses of Ann Fondren and Janie Morrell to attend the Auditor's Conference at San Antonio in November 1975. All voted yes, none voted no.

A motion was made by Commissioner Best and seconded by Commissioner Belt to approve County Extensions' monthly report. All voted yes, none voted no.

A motion was made by Commissioner Parks and seconded by Commissioner Best to authorize County Treasurer to mail Bicentennial material at the Countys' expense. All voted yes, none voted no.

A motion was made by Commissioner Parks and seconded by Commissioner Belt to authorize Sheriff Craven to get specificate cost for construction building at tower sight north of Doucette. All voted yes, none voted no.


A motion was made by Commissioner Parks and seconded by Commissioner Belt to table request of Irene Amasher of \$50.00 per month for delivering meals. All voted yes, none voted no.

A motion was made by Commissioner Belt and seconded by Commissioner Best to advertize for bids on leasing the operation and maintenance of the Solid Waste Sanitary Land Fill. Bids to be submitted on or before November 10, 1975 at 10:00 a.m. All voted yes, none voted no. (See County Judge for specifications.)

A motion was made by Commissioner Parks and seconded by Commissioner Belt to approve request of County Auditor to allocate the Revenue Sharing entitlement #6 first quarter as follows: Solid Waste \$20,246.70---Tax Office \$16,905.46---Sheriff Car \$3,700.75---Unencumbered \$761.09 for the total amount of \$41,614.00. All voted yes, none voted no.

A motion was made by Commissioner Belt and seconded by Commissioner Best to table appoint of the Board Members for the Child Welfare board of Tyler County. All voted yes, none voted no.

There being no futher business the Meeting adjourned.

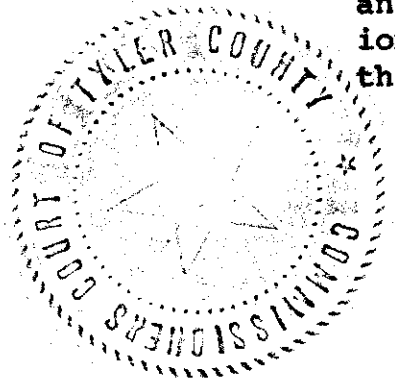
