The regular meeting of the Commissioner's Court for November 10, 1975, was opened with a prayer with all members present.

A motion was made by Commissioner Jordan and seconded by Commissioner Belt that the request from the Tyler County Chamber of Commerce for funds to publish and distribute information on Tyler County be tabled. All voted yes, none voted no.

A motion was made by Commissioner Belt and seconded by Commissioner Parks to terminate all appointed Deputy Constables effective December 31, 1975. All voted yes, none voted no.

Commissioner Belt made a motion to approve and sign the Tax Roll for 1975. This was seconded by Commissioner Parks. All voted yes, none voted no.

A motion was made by Commissioner Jordan and seconded by Commissioner Parks to continue the present Hospital Insurance coverage which is now in force. All voted yes, none voted no.

A motion was made by Commissioner Belt and seconded by Commissioner Parks that the Old Grimes Ferry Road, up to the Government property line, be declared a County road. All voted yes, none voted no.

Commissioner Parks made a motion to allocate to the Tyler County Historical Commission, an additional \$175.00 which is in addition to the \$300.00 already allocated. This motion was seconded by Commissioner Belt. All voted yes, none voted no.

Commissioner Belt made the motion to approve the County Extension Service Report. This was seconded by Commissioner Best. All voted yes, none voted no.

A motion to approve the bills as submitted and approved by the Auditor's office was made by Commissioner Parks and seconded by Commissioner Best. See attached copy. All voted yes, none voted no.

Commissioner Jordan made a motion to approve the payment of a \$29.00 dental bill for Wayne Brandin. This was seconded by Commissioner Best. All voted yes, none voted no.

Commissioner Belt made a motion to authorize the County Judge to sign the resolution concerning the County's cooperation with the District Attorney's office. See attached resolution. This was seconded by Commissioner Best. All voted yes and none voted no.

Commissioner Belt made a motion to canvas the results of the Constitutional Revision Election held on November 4, 1975, and to publish the results as official. See attached results. This was seconded by Commissioner Parks. All voted yes and none voted no.

Commissioner Best made a motion, which was seconded by Commissioner Parks to allocate \$500.00 to the Tyler County Chamber of Commerce for use in publishing and distributing materials. All voted yes, none voted no.

Commissioner Parks made a motion to authorize the County Clerk to attend the Bureau of Vital Statistics meeting in Austin on December 1 and 2, 1975, and to pay his expenses. All voted yes, none voted no.

Since there was no further business, the meeting was adjourned.
