The regular meeting of the Tyler County Commissioner's Court met on Monday, March 8, 1976, at 10:00 with all members present. The meeting opened with a prayer.

A motion was made by Commissioner Best and seconded by Commissioner Jordan to purchase two new radar units from Custom Electronics for the Highway Patrol with Rev. sharing funds. All voted yes and none voted no.

Commissioner Belt made a motion which was seconded by Commissioner Parks to table the question of despositions of two old radar units for further study. All voted yes and none voted no.

Commissioner Belt made a motion to approve the County Treasurer's Report for February 1976. This was seconded by Commissioner Best. All voted yes and none voted no. See attached copy of report.

Commissioner Parks made a motion to approve the County Extension's Service Report. This was seconded by Commissioner Best. All voted yes and none voted no.

A motion was made by Commissioner Best and seconded by Commissioner Belt to approve the payment of bills as submitted and approved by the County Auditor. See attached copy. All voted yes and none, no.

Commissioner Best made a motion to increase the cost allowed for meals for feeding the prisoners to \$2.00 per meal. This will be effective starting March 1, 1976. This was seconded by Judge Mann. All voted yes and none voted no.

Commissioner Jordan made a motion to advertise for bids for the purchase of a new truck for Precinct #4. This was seconded by Commissioner Parks. All voted yes and none voted no.

Commissioner Parks made a motion which was seconded by Commissioner Belt to advertise for bids for two new typewriters; One for the County Judge's office and the other for the County Auditor's office. All voted yes and none voted no.

Commissioner Jordan made a motion which was seconded by Commissioner Parks to enter an order in the minutes as follows: If monthly reports of elected officials are 30 days past due, then their books will be made available to the County Auditor for immediate audit. All voted yes and none voted no.

Commissioner Jordan made a motion that a dirt road off Highway 1746 be declared a public road. This was seconded by Commissioner Belt. See attached map. All voted yes and none voted no.

Commissioner Jordan made a motion which was seconded by Commissioner Best to issue a call for the County School Trustee election to be held on April 3, 1976. The purpose of said election is to elect Trustees in Pct. #1, Pct. #3 and Trustee at large. All voted yes and none voted no.

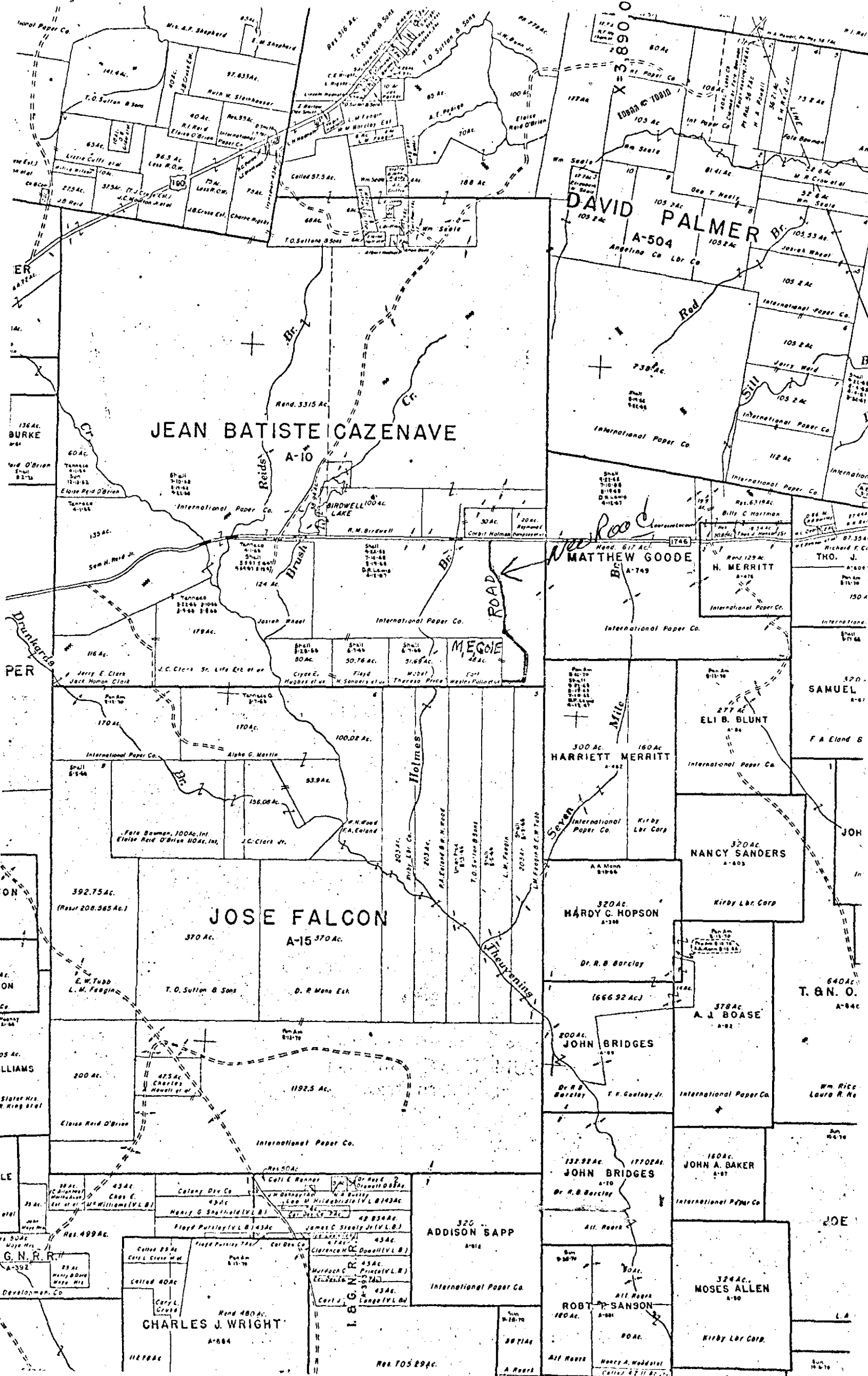
There being no further business, the meeting was adjourned.
