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The combined meeting of the Tyler County Commissioner's Court and the Woodville City Council reconvened Monday, March 29, 1976, at 5:30 P.M. An earlier meeting, at 11:45 A.M., Friday, March 26, 1976, had been recessed until the above stated time of 5:30 P.M. All Commissioner's were present and all City Council members were present except the Mayor, Grady James. The meeting opened with a prayer.

Commissioner Best made a motion which was seconded by Commissioner Belt, to accept the joint recommendations of the City Council and the Commissioner's Court to award Phase I Contract on the County-City Jail to Prindle, Patrick, & Partners, Ltd. in association with Don Cole for the contract price of \$7,900.00 with the understanding that the \$2,100.00 balance in grant is to apply to the start of Phase II. The final contract is to be signed March 30, 1976, by the County Judge and the Mayor Protem. All voted yes and none voted no.

Commissioner Jordan made a motion which was seconded by Commissioner Belt to adopt the resolution to install a teletype in the Sheriff's office on a 75% Criminal Justice Division and a 25% cost basis. The City and County will share the 25% which will be approximately \$50.00 per month. See attached copy. All voted yes and none, no.

There being no further business, the meeting was adjourned.

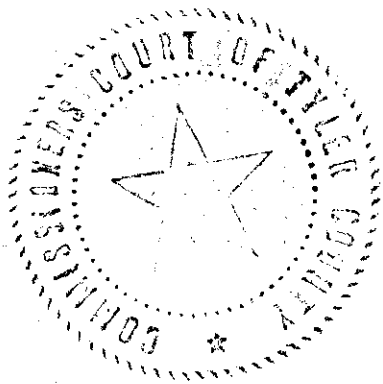

R E S O L U T I O N


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WHEREAS, The Commissioners' Court of Tyler County, Texas, meeting on 24th of March did pass favorably to support the Application of the Tyler County Sheriff's Department for the acquisition of a Teletype Terminal to be located in the Tyler County Sheriff's Office.

WHEREAS, It is understood by the Commissioners' Court that the Teletype will be supported by a Grant from the Texas Criminal Justice Division, Office of the Governor, on a 75%-25% basis. The cost to Tyler County will be approximately \$50.00 per month for one year with a one time charge of approximately \$9.00.

BE IT THEREFORE RESOLVED That Tyler County intends to assume full support of the Teletype System after the year of the Grant support provided the System proves its worth to the County during its initial year of operation.
