

COMMISSIONER'S COURT
SPECIAL MEETING
May 28, 1976

A special meeting of the Commissioner's Court met at 9:00 A.M. on Friday, May 28, 1976. The meeting opened with a prayer. All members were present.

Commissioner Parks made a motion which was seconded by Commissioner Best to accept the bid of Lufkin Tractor and Equipment Co. to purchase from Tyler County the Grade All Machine for a bid price of (\$1,025.00) One thousand twenty five dollars. All voted yes and none no. See attached bids.

Judge Mann made a motion to employ a secretary for the Highway Patrol office. This motion was seconded by Commissioner Jordan. All voted yes and none voted no.

Commissioner Parks made a motion to approve payment of bills as submitted and approved by the County Auditor. This motion was seconded by Commissioner Best. Voting yes were Commissioner's Parks, Jordan and Best. Commissioner Fowler abstained.

A motion was made by Commissioner Best and seconded by Commissioner Parks to approve the bond of Commissioner Leon Fowler of Pct. #3. All voted yes and none voted no.

A motion was made by Commissioner Jordan to accept the bid of Ogden Chevrolet Company bid of \$4,275.00 for a new car for the Sheriff's office. There was no second so the motion was ruled dead.

Commissioner Best made a motion which was seconded by Commissioner Parks to authorize the County Auditor to purchase one 4 drawer filing cabinet for the Auditor's office and one 5 drawer filing cabinet for the District Clerk's office. All voted yes and none no.

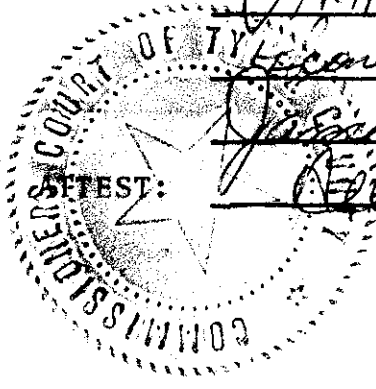
Commissioner Best made a motion which was seconded by Commissioner Jordan to re-appoint L.P. Hicks, Carl Fairchild and J.B. (Toby) Spurlock to two year terms on the Tyler County Hospital Board. All voted yes and none, no.

Commissioner Jordan made a motion which was seconded by Commissioner Best to authorize the District Clerk to advertise for bids to purchase a new air conditioning for the District Clerk's office. It must be at least 10,000 BTU heating and 12,000 BTU cooling. Bids must include installation. Bids will be opened at 10:00 A.M., June 14, 1976. If accepted, the money will be paid out of Revenue Sharing. All voted yes and none voted no.

Commissioner Parks made a motion which was seconded by Commissioner Best to table the approving of the Sheriff's report until the regular meeting in June. All voted yes and none voted no.

There being no further business, the meeting was adjourned.
