A special meeting of the Tyler County's Commissioner's Court was held at 10:00 A.M., Friday, June 18, 1976. This meeting was recessed until 1:00 P.M. on Friday, June 18, 1976. The meeting opened with a prayer with the following present: Commissioner's Parks, Fowler, Jordan and Judge Mann. Commissioner Best was absent.

Commissioner Fowler made a motion which was seconded by Commissioner Parks to authorize the County to participate with the Council of Governments Manpower Program in Automotive Heavy Equipment **Mechanic** and to employ Joe Marshall at a salary of \$950.00 per month which includes use of a pickup and tools, and to employ a helper at \$500.00 per month. This is a 50-50 grant--County to pay 50% and Council of Government to pay 50%. The County part to be paid 75% out of 4 precincts Road & Bridge and 25% out of Solid Waste and Sheriff's Dept. A daily trip log will be kept and gasoline will be furnished while traveling on the job. All voted yes and none voted no.

A motion was made by Commissioner Fowler and seconded by Commissioner Jordan to table the question of an audit for further study. Voting yes were Commissioners Jordan and Fowler. Voting no was Commissioner Parks.

Commissioner Parks made a motion which was seconded by Commissioner Fowler to table the organization of the Board of Equalization until Monday, June 21, 1976. All voted yes and none voted no.

Meeting was re-convened until 10:00 A.M. Monday, June 21, 1976. All members were present. The meeting opened with a prayer.

The Commissioner's Court organized themselves into the Board of Equalization and each Commissioner and the Judge took an oath as a Board of Equalization member.

Commissioner Jordan made a motion which was seconded by Commissioner Parks to set the following date for the Board of Equalization meetings: August 9 & 10 for individuals, August 11th for Timber Companies, August 12th for Oil Companies, Pipe Line Companies, Utilities, Telephones, Railroads, and other commercial properties. All meetings will begin at 9:00 A.M. each day and the County Clerk was directed to put a notice of the Board of Equalization meetings in the County newspaper. All voted yes and none voted no.

The Board of Equalization was recessed until a meeting is called or until August 9, 1976.

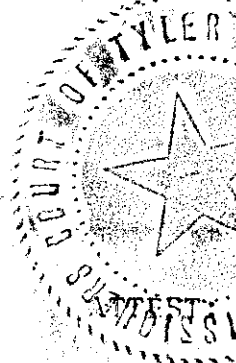
Commissioner Parks made a motion which was seconded by Commissioner Best to rescind action taken April 12, 1976 authorizing the Sheriff to employ an additional dispatcher. All voted yes and none voted no.

Commissioner Fowler made a motion which was seconded by Commissioner Jordan to require that each repair bill and each gasoline purchase be signed by the person making the bill and that automobile numbers be placed on each bill. All voted yes and none voted no.

Commissioner Fowler made a motion to direct the County Auditor to contact Arthur Young and Co. about the feasibility of doing a County Audit. This motion was seconded by Commissioner Jordan. Voting for were Commissioner's Best, Jordan and Fowler. Voting against was Commissioner Parks.

There being no further business, the meeting was adjourned.
