The regular meeting of the Tyler County Commissioner's Court met Monday, June 14, 1976 at 10:00 A.M. The meeting opened with a prayer and all members present.

Commissioner Fowler made a motion which was seconded by Commissioner Parks to close down the Solid Waste Pickup system in Tyler County for a 90 day period, at least, to be effective no later than June 30, 1976, however, to keep the Solid Waste Disposal Dump site open 7 days each week to allow citizens to utilize the dump area themselves. All voted yes and none voted no.

Commissioner Jordan made a motion for the County to accept an easement 50 feet wide and containing 2,464 acres of land in the W. F. Slaughter Survey, A-31. This motion was seconded by Commissioner Parks. See attached description. All voted yes and none voted no.

Commissioner Best made a motion which was seconded by Commissioner Jordan to accept the County Treasurer's report for May 1976. See the attached copy. All voted yes and none voted no.

Commissioner Parks made a motion to pay the bills as submitted and approved by the County Auditor. This was seconded by Commissioner Best. See the attached copy. All voted yes and none voted no.

Commissioner Best made a motion which was seconded by Commissioner Parks to pay out of the Revenue Sharing, a bill of \$275.75 for the Tyler County Bicentennial Committee. This is to be taken out of a \$300.00 budget to the Tyler County Historical Commission. All voted yes and none voted no.

Commissioner Parks made a motion to approve the County Extension Service report. This motion was seconded by Commissioner Jordan. All voted yes and none voted no.

Commissioner Fowler made a motion which was seconded by Commissioner Jordan to approve the bond of R. A. Jernigan as Independent Weigher for Tyler County. All voted yes and none voted no.

Commissioner Jordan made a motion which was seconded by Commissioner Best to authorize the Tyler County Judge to sign the resolution concerning the grant of Texas Aeronautics Commission Amendment #1 on projects #742-2-35098 and #742-4-025180. See attached copy. All voted yes and none voted no.

Commissioner Jordan made a motion which was seconded by Commissioner Parks that the Constables of Tyler County be allowed to retain their radios and radar units and that they be removed from the Sheriff's inventory and be placed on the Constables inventory. All voted yes and none voted no.

Commissioner Parks made a motion which was seconded by Commissioner Best to authorize the County Judge to sign an amendment to the Texas Highway Interlock Cooperative Act contract #7674-20-220-1, Tyler County, and to extend the expiration date to June 30, 1976, and to increase the available funds to \$3,750.00. See attached contract. All voted yes and none voted no.

Commissioner Parks made a motion which was seconded by Commissioner Jordan to accept the bid of \$364.75 from Rusty's Heating and Air Conditioning Co. for the air conditioner for the District Clerk's office. This is to be paid out of the Revenue Sharing Fund. See attached bids. All voted yes and none voted no.

Commissioner Best made a motion which was seconded by Commissioner Fowler to have an audit made of the Tyler County offices for 1975. Voting yes were Commissioner's Fowler, Best and Jordan. Commissioner Parks abstained. Motion passed.

Commissioner Fowler made a motion which was seconded by Commissioner Jordan to table the question of who shall audit the Tyler County books until Friday, June 18, 1976. Voting yes were Commissioner's Best, Fowler and Jordan. Commissioner Parks abstained. Motion passed.

Commissioner Best made a motion which was seconded by Commissioner Fowler that the jail fund account be allocated \$16,172.00 out of the next Revenue Sharing Entitlement. Voting for, were Commissioner's Best, Fowler and Mann. Against were Commissioner's Jordan and Parks. Motion passed.

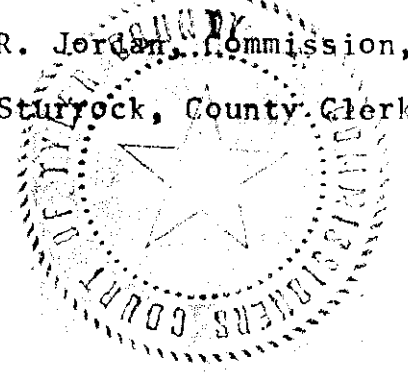
Commissioner Best made a motion which was seconded by Commissioner Fowler to budget the planned Revenue Sharing use reports: Public Safety, \$16,172.00; Financial Administration, \$13,000.00; Multiple Purpose and Government, \$12,195.00; Environmental Protection, \$10,000; Libraries, \$6,500.00 and Public Transportation, \$20,000.00. Voting for was Commissioner Best, Fowler and Parks. Voting against was Commissioner Jordan. Motion passed.

Commissioner Parks made a motion which was seconded by Commissioner Fowler to remove the \$5.00 charges per load for the City of Woodville's use of the Solid Waste Disposal Dump, retroactive to the time the charge was imposed. All voted yes and none voted no.

There being no further business, the meeting was adjourned.

AMENDMENT NO. 1 TO GRANT AGREEMENT

WHEREAS, the Texas Aeronautics Commission, has determined it to be in the interest of the State of Texas that the Grant Agreement between the Director, Texas Aeronautics Commission, acting by and on behalf of the State of Texas and Tyler County, Texas, (hereinafter referred to as the "Sponsor"), accepted by said Sponsor on April 14, 1975, relating to Tyler County Airport, Woodville, Texas, Project Nos. 742-4-35098 and 742-4025180, be amended as hereinafter provided:

NOW THEREFORE, WITNESSETH:

That in consideration of the benefits to accrue to the parties hereto, the State of Texas on the one part, and the Sponsor, on the other part, do hereby mutually agree that the said Grant Agreement shall be and hereby is amended:

- 1. By increasing the maximum amount of the obligation of the State of Texas payable under the Grant Agreement (paragraph 2, page 2) from \$31,000 to \$50,000.
2. All other terms of the grant shall remain unchanged.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, the parties hereto have caused this Amendment to the said Grant Agreement to be duly executed as of the 1st day of June, 1976.
