A motion was made by Commissioner Best and seconded by Commissioner Parks to authorize the Sherriff to have car repaired for inspection by Joe Marshall. All voted yes, none voted no.

There being no further business, the meeting was adjourned.

A regular meeting of the Tyler County Commissioner's Court met on Monday, July 12, 1976 at 10:00 A.M. All members were present and the meeting opened with a prayer.

A motion was made by Commissioner Best and seconded by Commissioner Fowler to approve County Treasurers report for June 1976. See attached report. All voted yes, none voted no.

A motion was made by Commissioner Parks and seconded by Commissioner Best to table bills from Texgas Company for Sherriff's office for further study. All voted yes, none voted no.

A motion was made by Commissioner Best and seconded By Commissioner Parks to approve a telephone for the Texas Employment Office located in the Courthouse and to pay telephone bills as they are presented. The telephone number is 283-6001. See attached bill. All voted yes, none voted no.

A motion was made by Commissioner Jordan and seconded by Commissioner Fowler to pay bill on bermuda grass seed and fertilize used at Boat Camp on Neches River at the New Bridge site on Hwy. 2628. All voted yes, none voted no.

A motion was made by Commissioner Jordan and seconded by Commissioner Parks to pay bill submitted by William Gill Concrete Company for joints of colverts. All voted yes, none voted no.'

A motion was made by Commissioner Best and seconded by Commissioner Fowler to not pay bill on Janitar Supplies from Madison Beoness Company in the amount of \$300.83 and check possibility of returning the goods for credit. All voted yes, none voted no.

A motion was made by Commissioner Parks and seconded by Commissioner Jordan to pay bills as submitted and approved by the County Auditor with the exceptions as noted in previous motions. See attached copy. All voted yes, none voted no.

A motion was made by Commissioner Fowler and seconded by Commissioner Jordan to appoint O.G. Tolbert as County Surveyor of Tyler County with the understanding that the County does not pay a salary or furnish office space or telephone. All voted yes, none voted no.

A motion was made by Commissioner Jordan and seconded by Commissioner Best to allocate out of Revenue Sharing \$5,000.00 to Solid Waste, this to be taken out of the balance of \$41,560.00 leaving a balance of \$36,560.00 to be budgeted on July 19, 1976. All voted yes, none voted no.

A motion was made by Commissioner Parks and seconded by Commissioner Best to Approve County Extension report for June 1976. All voted yes, none voted no.

A motion was made by Commissioner Best and seconded by Commissioner Fowler to approve purchase of one calculator for the Auditor's office for \$187.50 and one calculator for the County Tax Office for \$187.50. This to be paid out of the Revenue Sharings. All voted yes, none voted no.

A motion was made by Commissioner Jordan and seconded by Commissioner Best to name the County road which goes East from Hwy 69 just north of the Hickory Creek bridge to the Triple (D) Ranch as (The Triple (D) Ranch Road). All voted yes, none voted no.

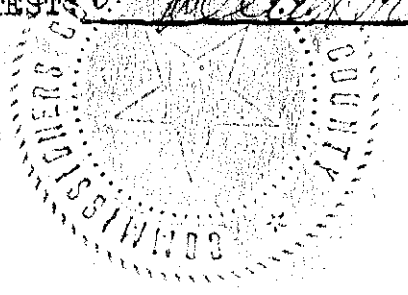
